SWCA has reviewed the attached memo regarding your site visit to Lot 11 on 9/24/2019. To ensure compliance with the project's Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) and Conditions of Approval (COA), please address the following items:

- Page 1 of the memo lists the COA measures that apply to Lot 11; however, there is no mention of Mitigation Measure BIO-2a. Mitigation Measure BIO-2a applies to Lot 11, therefore SWCA recommends including it on this list.
- Page 2 summarizes the findings of the California red-legged frog (CRLF) survey. Mitigation Measure BIO-2d states that the pre-construction CRLF survey shall occur "immediately preceding initial ground disturbance activities on Lot 11". Therefore, a follow-up pre-construction CLRF survey will be required, ideally the same day as the start of ground disturbing activities.
- Page 2 states "Ms. Peterson also surveyed the property for woodrat houses. No new houses have been established; there are two houses on the perimeter, outside the construction zone." Please include a map showing the location of the woodrat houses. How far are they from the impact area? As per Mitigation Measure BIO-2a, the survey needs to determine if active woodrat nests (stickhouses) with young are present within the disturbance zone or within 100 feet of the disturbance zone. If active woodrat nests (stickhouses) with young are identified, a fence shall be erected around the nest site adequate to provide the woodrat sufficient foraging habitat at the discretion of a qualified biologist and based on consultation with the CDFG.

Regarding the relocation of the Woodrat middens/nests on Lot 9, SWCA recommends the following:

An email notice to the County of when you plan to complete the relocation, and a follow up email or memo confirming completion of the relocation. In your post-relocation email/memo, SWCA recommends that you include a map showing which middens were relocated, and where they were relocated to. Also, SWCA recommends that you strictly follow Mitigation Measure BIO-2a when relocating the nests. MM BIO-2a reads as follows: "...If woodrats are observed within the disturbance footprint outside of the breeding period, individuals shall be relocated to a suitable location within the open space by a qualified biologist in possession of a scientific collecting permit. This will be accomplished by

dismantling woodrat nests (outside of the breeding period), to allow individuals to relocate to suitable habitat within the adjacent open space."
