

Hello Erica,

I'm sure you have received several emails regarding the above, so I will keep it short. I have lived at bottom of Palomar for close to 40 years – moved here due to rural & beautiful area with space and homes (most of them) that complimented the area. The current design planned for 634 Palomar is in my opinion not at all for this area – it looks more like an office or dental building than a home. The home will be situated at the top of the hill where it will be seen by all who drive, walk, bike on the main road.

I'm also concerned about the stability of the hill as there have been parts of that area that have slid and given way over the years – I believe due to the extremely steep hill, the work that will be required will probably undermine the hill and cause damage to the surrounding area including Los Cerros & Palomar Dr.

This whole area, including my street have known issues with land & soil instability – I believe construction will cause land movement, instability and could cause road damage & road/hill collapse. And, the design just does not fit in the surrounding area and it's location will be an eyesore for the whole area.
