a)	Joe LoCoco Status of permanent radar feedback signs on Santa Cruz Ave – want to know where these signs will be located. Solar powered signs cannot be installed on this corridor where trees shade the solar panels. Therefore, we are waiting on the electricians to schedule an inspection of the units and of the site to install PG&E power meters etc.
	Task Force also agreed that we should use one sign model rather than have a mix of different models for the radar feedback signs. So DPW will reorder a new set of radar feedback signs.
