Commission on Disabilities

President of the Board of Supervisors Don Horsley announced that applications are being accepted for appointment to the Commission on Disabilities. Currently, there are six (6) Community At-Large positions vacant for this commission. To be eligible, applicants must be a resident of San Mateo County.

This 21-member Commission promotes programs that address quality of service and positive attitude about people with disabilities; review and report on availability and accessibility of community services to people with special needs; establish a channel of communication with the community to garner input and educate the public to the needs of persons with disabilities.

General Meetings are held virtually during the COVID-19 pandemic on the 4th Thursday/month at 3:00 PM, and thereafter to be held at 455 County Center, Room 101, Redwood City. Commissioners are also expected to participate in a minimum of one committee meeting per month of their choosing.
