## What is the ACE Program?

Health coverage keeps you healthy and covered when you need it most.



San Mateo County Access and Care for Everyone (ACE) is a low-cost health coverage option for San Mateo County residents.

ACE services are only covered by designated providers:

- San Mateo Medical Center's main campus and clinics
- Ravenswood Family Health Center
- North East Medical Services

Once enrolled, you will select a clinic where you will receive primary care, any referrals to specialized medical services, and a designated pharmacy where you can pick up prescriptions.

#### Can I apply?

#### Sign up for coverage with ACE if you:

- Are a San Mateo County resident, aged 19 or older, regardless of immigration status.
- 2. Have income between 138% 200% Federal Poverty Level (FPL). FPL levels differ depending on the size of your family.
- 3. Are not eligible for Medicare, Full Scope Medi-Cal with or without a Share-of Cost, Covered California, private insurance, or other third-party payers.

All ACE applicants must apply for Medi-Cal with or without a share of cost if eligible.

If your income is below 138% FPL, you may be eligible for the ACE Fee Waiver program. There would be no enrollment fee or co-pays.

## **How much does the ACE Program Cost?**

The ACE Program has an annual enrollment fee of \$360 per person and can be paid in monthly installments. This fee is nonrefundable; however, it can be waived for those with both a chronic health condition and a financial hardship. HPSM will mail the invoices and include a prepaid envelope for you to mail in your payments. Payments can be made by check, cashier's check or money orders.

With ACE, the most you would pay out of pocket annually is \$1,000 (\$360 enrollment and \$640 in co-payments). Co-payments range from:

- \$7 Prescriptions
- \$15 Primary Care
- \$15 Diabetes, Asthma, Hypertension Visit
- \$75 Emergency Room Visit
- \$300 Same Day Surgery
