Complete the application and interview with your county.

This will happen by phone or inperson, at the same time as you apply. For online applications, the county will call you.

Pick up your EBT card. If you are approved for Disaster CalFresh food benefits, your county will tell you when and where to pick up your EBT card. An EBT card is like a debit card which you'll use to purchase food.
