First 5 San Mateo County

President of the Board of Supervisors Dave Pine announced that applications are being accepted for appointment to the First 5 San Mateo County. **There is currently one (1) upcoming vacancy representing: Public Member, to commence January 1, 2024.** The Public Member includes the following categories: recipients of project services included in First 5 San Mateo County's Strategic Plan; educators specializing in early childhood development; representatives of a local child care resource or referral agency or a local child care coordinating group; representatives of a local organization for prevention or early intervention for families at risk; representatives of community-based organizations that have the goal of promoting nurturing and early childhood development; representatives of local school districts; and representatives of local medical pediatric or obstetric associations or societies, and parents/caregivers of young children To be eligible, applicants must be a resident of the County of San Mateo.

The mission of the First 5 Commission is to promote positive outcomes for young children and their families through strategic investments, community leadership, and effective partnerships.
