## B. JPCF/JJCPA & YOBG/JJRBG RFPs Update

Management Analyst, Tony Burchyns, shared an overview on the recent RFP process and the programs and services that will be funded for the next three fiscal years.

- 22 contracts were awarded to 11 CBOs.
- Community based services are funded by JPCF and JJCPA.
- Programs and services for youth in custody are funded by YOBG.
- Programs and services for older youth realigned from DJJ are funded by JJRBG.
- A total of \$5,603,193 was awarded through the RFP process.

Chief Keene shared that these processes are established by a 5-year local action plan. The plan details what was determined needed within our individual county for the youth we serve, and every county is different. A lot of factors many which are driven by positive outcomes and primarily that we have less youth in our facility compared to many years ago has impacted the programming we have available today compared to what was available in the past. The current list of programs and services shows a conservative effort towards everything that was in the recommendations the department received from JJDPC, an alignment with the plan for the SB823 population, and an ongoing effort in partnership of both the system and external partners to look at what can be provided that will be meaningful and impactful to our specific population.

The Annual Comprehensive Report with more detailed information on the programs and services that were provided this past fiscal year will be shared at the next JJCC meeting in November.

## **C.** Future JJCC Meeting Format

A motion was put forth to move the JJCC meetings to a hybrid format to allow for remote public participation in the new year.

Supervisor Corzo requested a report out on youth in detention and stats on arrests per quarter at future JJCC meetings.

➤ Chief Keene shared that this information is already shared in other spaces and has not typically been part of this commission, but he will look into this and think about the best way to get this information out.

Kate Hiester asked about what the process is to determine a voting member of the HCC

➤ Chief Keene shared that a lot of it is statutory driven and a reflection on why this commission was put together would be beneficial since there are a lot of new faces on the commission.
