

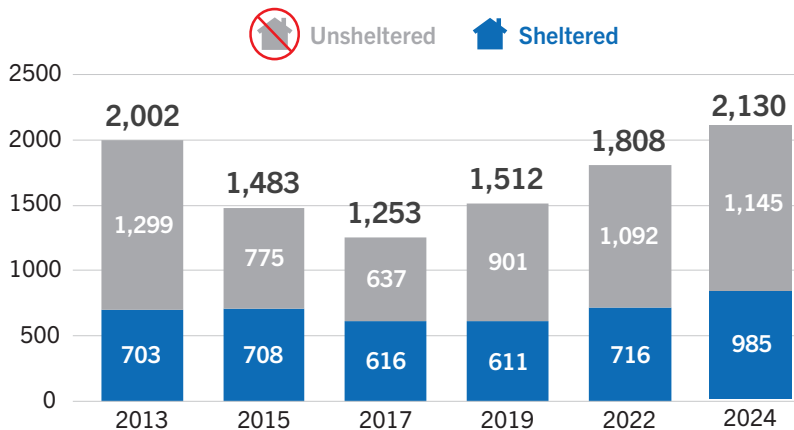

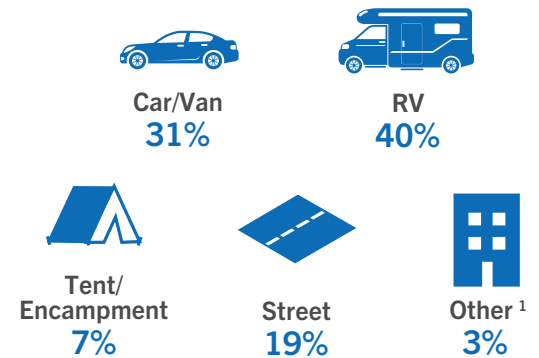
ONE DAY HOMELESS COUNT AND SURVEY

The San Mateo County Human Services Agency (HSA), in close collaboration with community partners, conducts the biennial One Day Homeless Count and Survey. The purpose of the One Day Homeless Count and Survey is to gather information to help the community understand homelessness in San Mateo County. The data we collect supports local planning, grant funding, and improving the programs that provide pathways to permanent housing. HSA conducted the Count on January 25, 2024 and administered the Survey between January 25, 2024 and February 1, 2024.

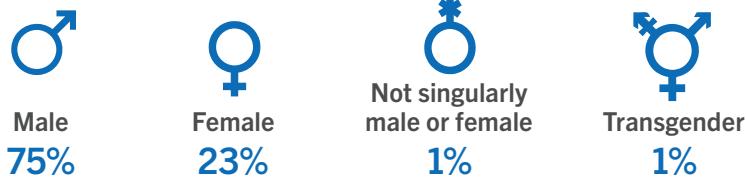
ONE DAY HOMELESS COUNT OVER TIME



UNSHELTERED SLEEPING LOCATIONS

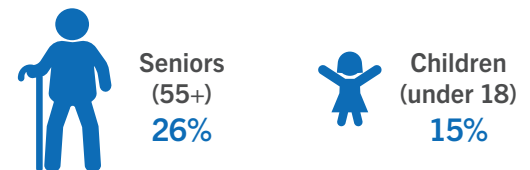


GENDER IDENTITY²

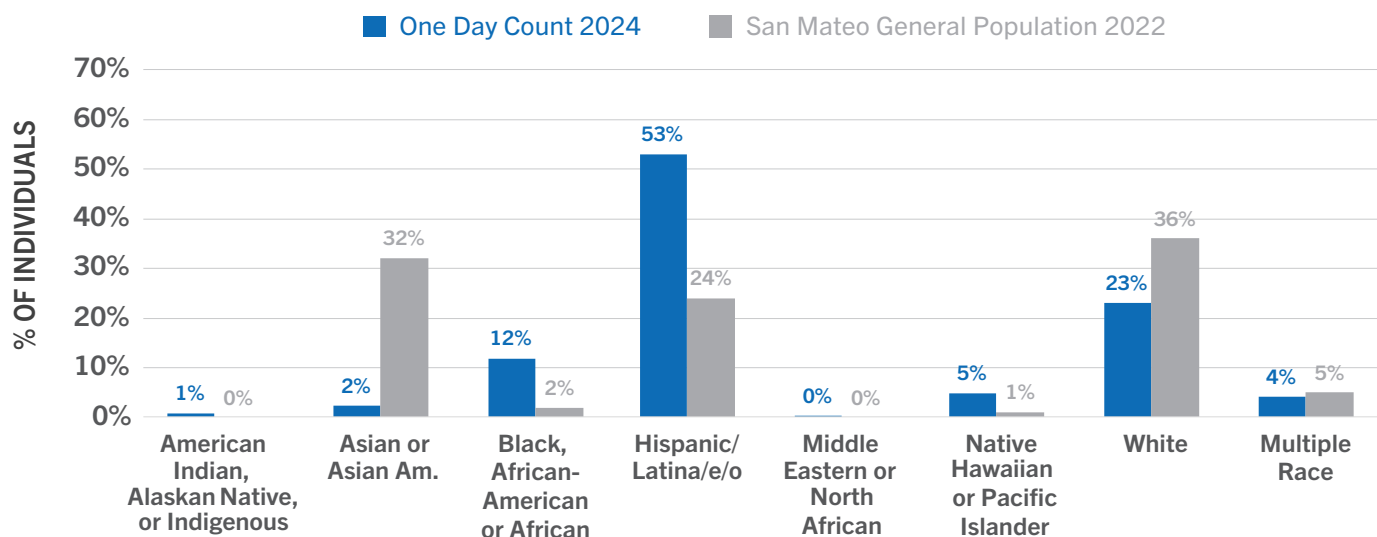
