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**RESOLUTION DIRECTING SUBMITTAL OF THE RECODIFIED AND RENUMBERED
PLANNING, BUILDING, AND SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS, TITLE 8 – ZONING &
DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, TITLE 9 - SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS, AND
TITLE 10 - BUILDING REGULATIONS OF THE SAN MATEO COUNTY ORDINANCE
CODE, AND THE AMENDMENT OF PART III OF THE COUNTY’S LOCAL COASTAL
PROGRAM, TO THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION FOR REVIEW AND
CERTIFICATION**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in November, 1980, the San Mateo County Local Coastal Program (LCP) was certified by the California Coastal Commission; and

WHEREAS, since its certification, the LCP has been amended at various times, to improve its conformity with the California Coastal Act or respond to local circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the various zoning regulations, subdivision regulations, and other regulations regarding development that apply in the County’s Coastal Zone constitute a part of the Implementation Plan for the LCP; and

WHEREAS, amendment of that Implementation Plan must be certified by the California Coastal Commission as conforming with the California Coastal Act, prior to taking effect in the County’s Coastal Zone; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the County's Local Coastal Program must also be certified by the California Coastal Commission as conforming with the California Coastal Act, prior to taking effect; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has adopted, by ordinance, the renumbering and recodification of the Planning, Building, and Subdivision regulations; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance constitutes an amendment to the Implementation Plan of the Local Coastal Program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has also adopted, by ordinance, amendments to the County's Local Coastal Program Implementation Plan, to ensure consistency between the Local Coastal Program Implementation Plan and the Planning, Building, and Subdivision regulations; and

WHEREAS, these amendments will not be effective in the County's Coastal Zone until they have been reviewed and certified by the California Coastal Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, resolves as follows:

The Planning and Building Department staff are directed to submit the renumbered and recodified Planning, Building, and Subdivision regulations and the amendment to Part III of the County's Local Coastal Program Implementation Plan to the California Coastal Commission for review and certification.
