## **2. Public Listening Session – Community Members Sharing Experiences about the Coastside Clinic through facilitated discussion.**

**Welcome, Agenda Review, Group Agreements, Introductions:**

- The purpose of this meeting is to provide feedback to the Board of Supervisors about how the Coastside Clinic (including the mobile clinic in Pescadero) is doing in serving residents and what can be improved.

**Listening Session/Breakout Groups:**

- Community members shared their experiences and feedback regarding the Coastside Clinic in breakout groups of four to nine people each.

- Three breakout groups were conducted in Spanish, and one was conducted in English. Participants provided responses to the following questions:
  - How often have you and your family used the clinic in the past year and for what purpose? (If you have not used the clinic, what is preventing you from using it?)
  - What do you like about the clinic and what is working well?
  - What concerns do you have about the clinic?
  - How could the clinic better address your and your family's health needs?

**Next Steps, Closing Remarks:**

- The facilitator will compile the feedback received at the meeting into a summary report that would be presented at the next Farmworker Advisory Commission meeting on March 12 in Pescadero.
- The Commission will review and discuss the feedback and identify possible recommendations regarding the Clinic to present to the Board of Supervisors.
