Approving an exemption to the requirement for 2 off street parking places is utterly insane in that area. Because so many people are living in each structure in South Fair Oaks ESPECIALLY ON WESTMORELAND cars are parked in front of fire hydrants, across driveways, within 20 feet of pedestrian crossings and even left in the middle of the street. On Westmoreland this is exacerbated by the commercial trucks left there. When parking on one street is blocked the cars migrate to the other surrounding streets and parking is impossible, especially in the evening. Many of the homes have only a 25 ft. frontage, yet the residents have multiple cars. This project would make the situation that much worse.
