**Strategy Implementation Considerations**

**Feasible?**

- Is the strategy based on data-driven insights and community needs?
- Does the strategy align with local, state, and federal regulations?
- Is there an evidence-based approach supporting this strategy's effectiveness?
- Can the initiative be successfully implemented given current constraints (e.g., financial, resources, support, etc.)?

**Realistic?**

- Are the goals and timelines achievable given available resources?
- Do we have a clear and structured implementation plan?
- Have we identified potential risks and developed mitigation strategies to address them?
- Is there a way to measure progress and make necessary adjustments as we go?
- Have similar strategies been implemented successfully in other communities?

**Resources?**

- Do we have the necessary funding sources identified and secured (e.g., existing budget, grants, external partners, etc.)?
- Do we have staff, materials, and infrastructure in place to implement the strategy?
- Is there a plan to sustain resources for the duration of the project and/or for long-term success or expansion?
- Have we leveraged partnerships and collaborations to maximize resources?
- Do we have the necessary training and expertise to execute the strategy?

**Support?**

- Have key stakeholders and decision-makers been engaged and informed?
- Is there a community outreach and engagement plan in place?
- Do we have mechanisms to collect feedback from stakeholders and/or the community and address concerns?
- Have we built partnerships with relevant organizations and agencies?
- Is there political and leadership support for the strategy's success?
