### Term

Each fellowship position is full-time and will typically last between two to three years, depending on the assignment and organization.

### Salary

Fellows will receive a competitive salary and benefits depending upon the complexity of the assignment and agency.

### Requirement for Applicants

Typically, applicants must either have a current Master's degree or in the last semester of their program. (Preferably in Public Administration or Public Policy) Please read each job announcement carefully as each announcement may have different requirements.
