CPP and FFPSA Updates	Community Pathway Overview - San Mateo is pursuing Community Pathway: creates a route for families to get referred to services without involvement with child welfare - Step 1: launch programs - Step 2: set up referral pathways



	• Step 3: Continuous Quality Improvement – providers need to demonstrate that they provide programs with model fidelity. County to keep track of whether or not the families who are receiving services are able to successfully stay out of foster care • Focus on how data will be collected and how the provider evaluates data Community Pathway Updates • Community Pathway work groups have discussed what constitutes eligibility for services • Update: the state will release a document that has more detail on how candidacy determination will work and include almost a dozen examples of what risk factors would qualify for services
