Enrollment sites are open Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 5:00 pm, except on holidays or as indicated below.

Cost of ACE

Enrollment Fee

- The ACE program charges an annual fee of \$360 per person that can be paid in monthly installments. The fee is non-refundable. Waivers are available for those with chronic conditions and a financial hardship. Invoices are sent by Health Plan of San Mateo (HPSM).
- The maximum annual out-of-pocket expense is \$1,000, including the enrollment fee and co-payments.

Co-Payments

Co-payments include:

- \$7 Prescription
- \$15 Primary Care
- \$15 Diabetes, Asthma, Hypertension Visit
- \$75 Emergency Room Visit
- \$300 Same Day Surgery

San Mateo County ACE Program

Access and Care for Everyone

ACE is an affordable health coverage program for San Mateo County residents who are not eligible for Medicare, Medi-Cal (with or without a Share-of-Cost), Covered California, private insurance, or other third-party payers.



Who is Eligible

Sign up for coverage with ACE if you:

- Are a San Mateo County resident 21 – 64 years of age, regardless of immigration status.
- Have income between 138% - 200% Federal Poverty Level (FPL). See Chart.
- Are not eligible for Medicare, Medi-Cal (with or without a Share-of Cost), Covered California, private insurance, or other third-party payers.

All ACE applicants must apply for Medi-Cal, if eligible.

What You Need to Apply

- **Proof of San Mateo County Address** A recent utility bill, billing statement, letter, or ID with current address
- **Proof of Income for the Household** (if applicable)
 - Recent employment stub
 - Government check stub (such as unemployment or disability)
 - Tax forms from the previous year
- **Proof of Identity** State ID, passport, or foreign ID
- **Social Security or Tax ID Number** (if applicable)
- **Proof of Resident Status** (for Legal Permanent Resident only) Residency Card, also known as “a Green Card”
- **Work Permit** (if applicable)
