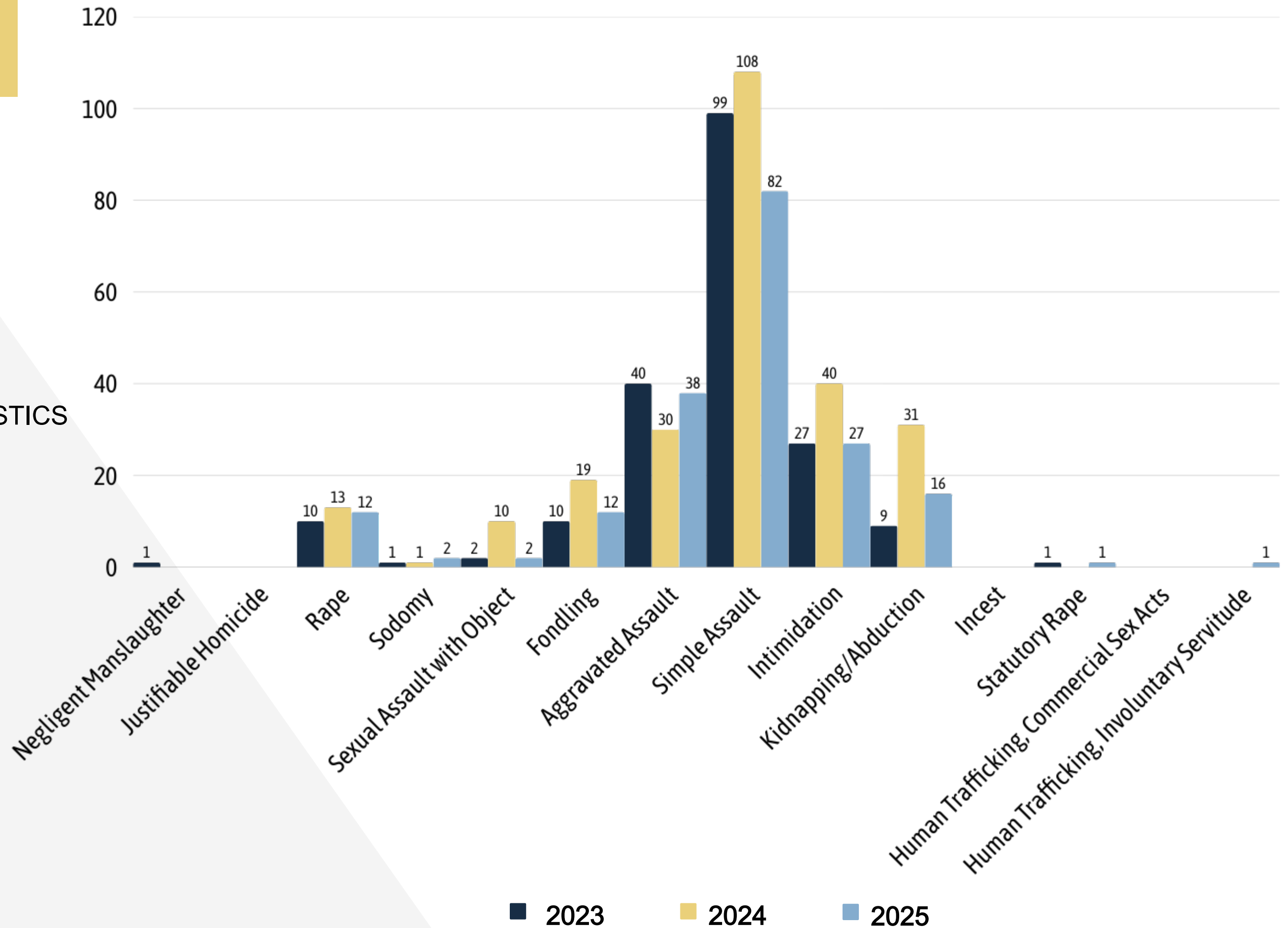

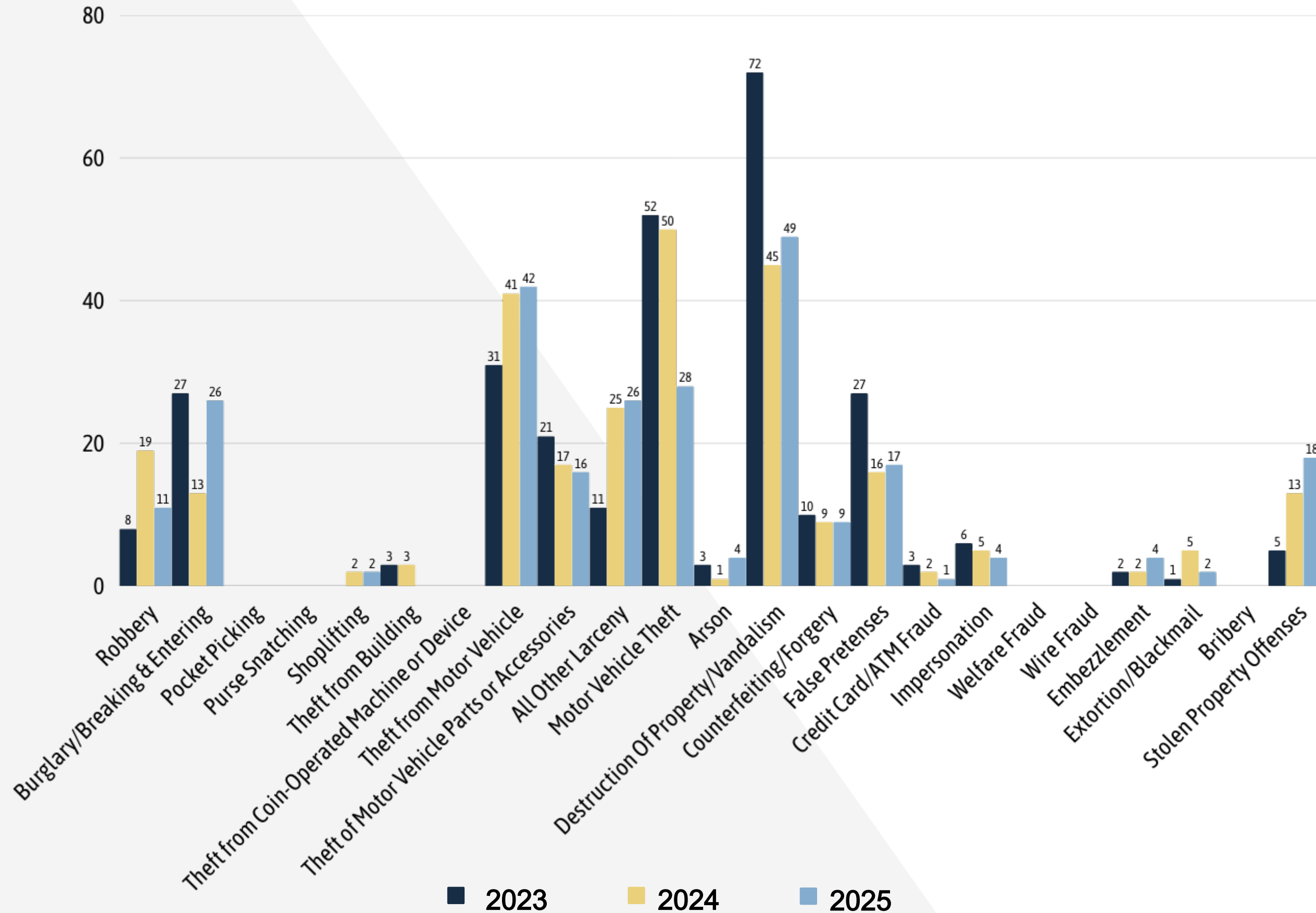

(JAN-DEC 31)



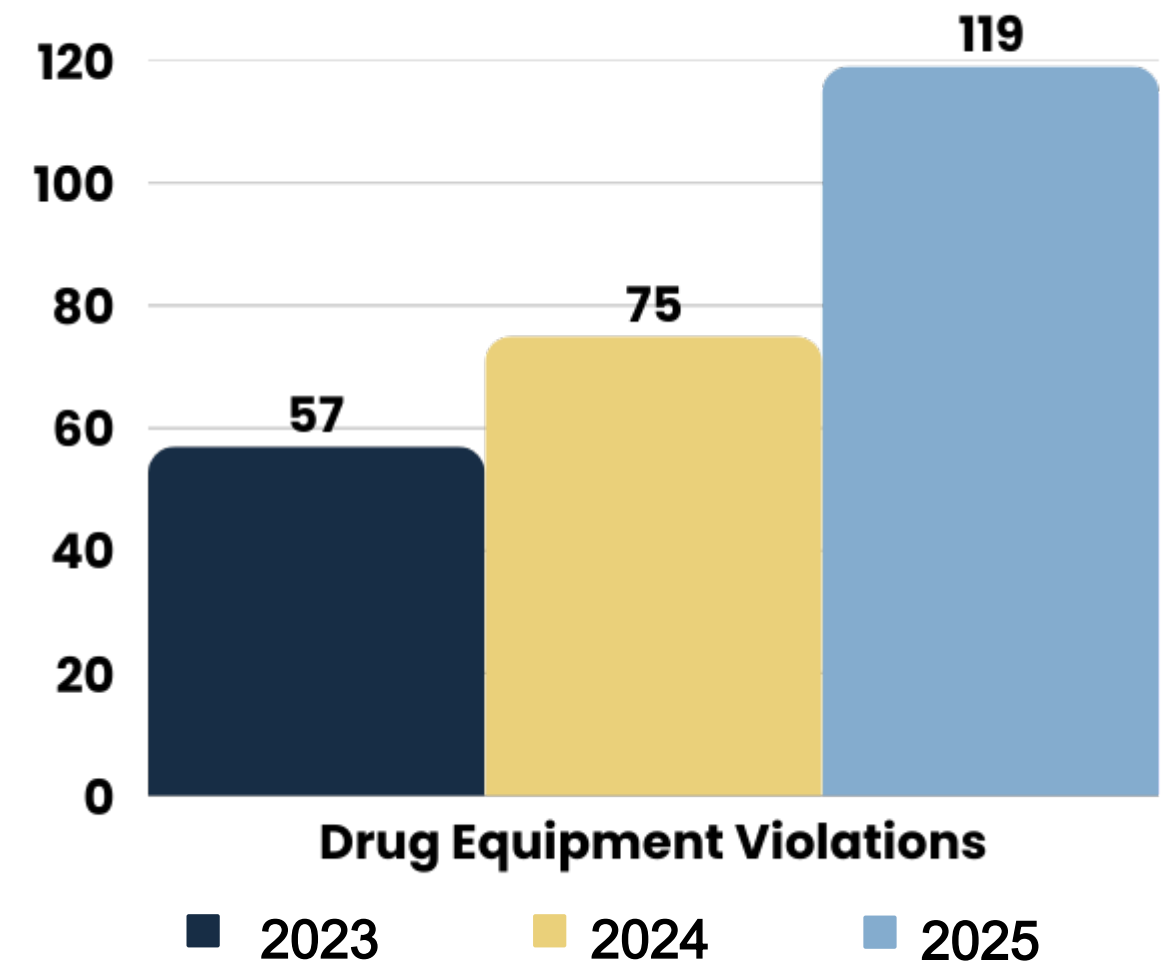
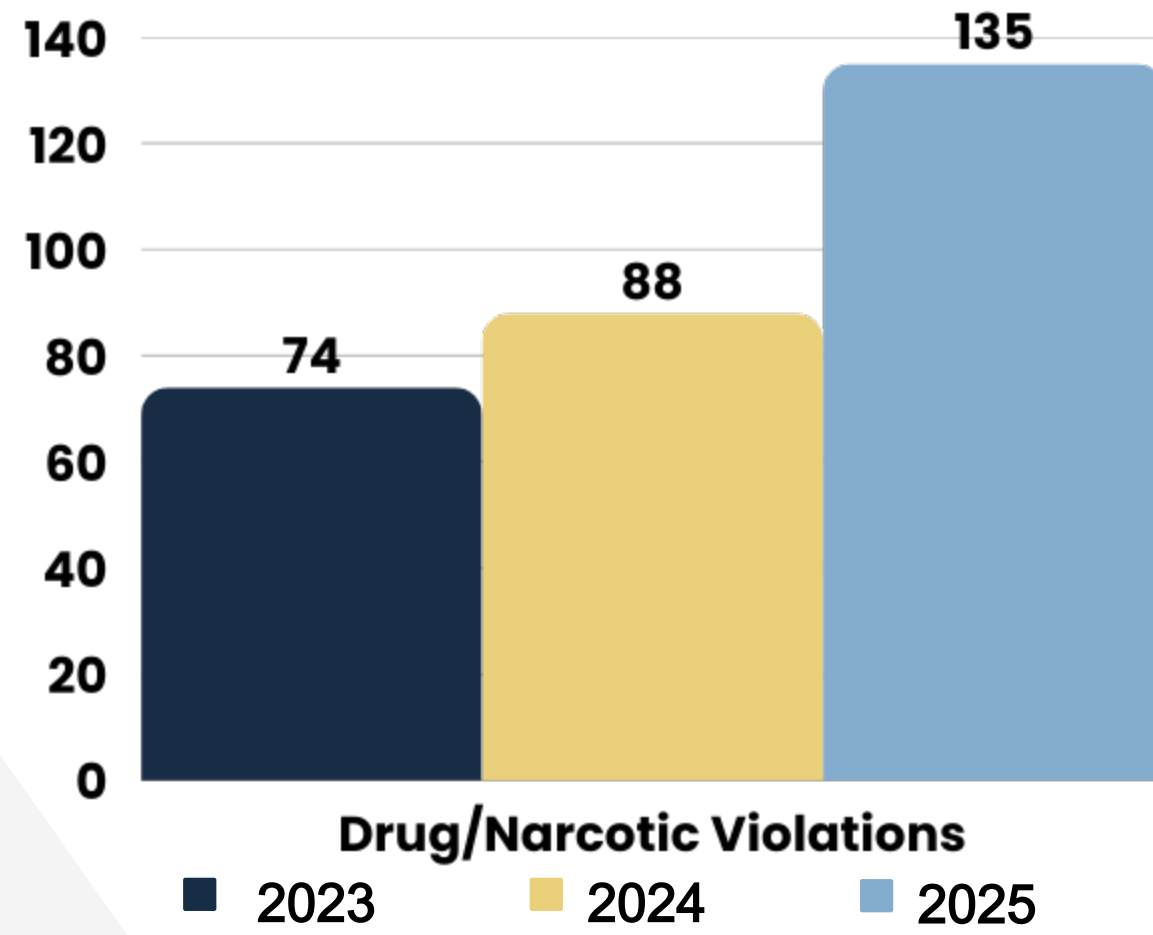

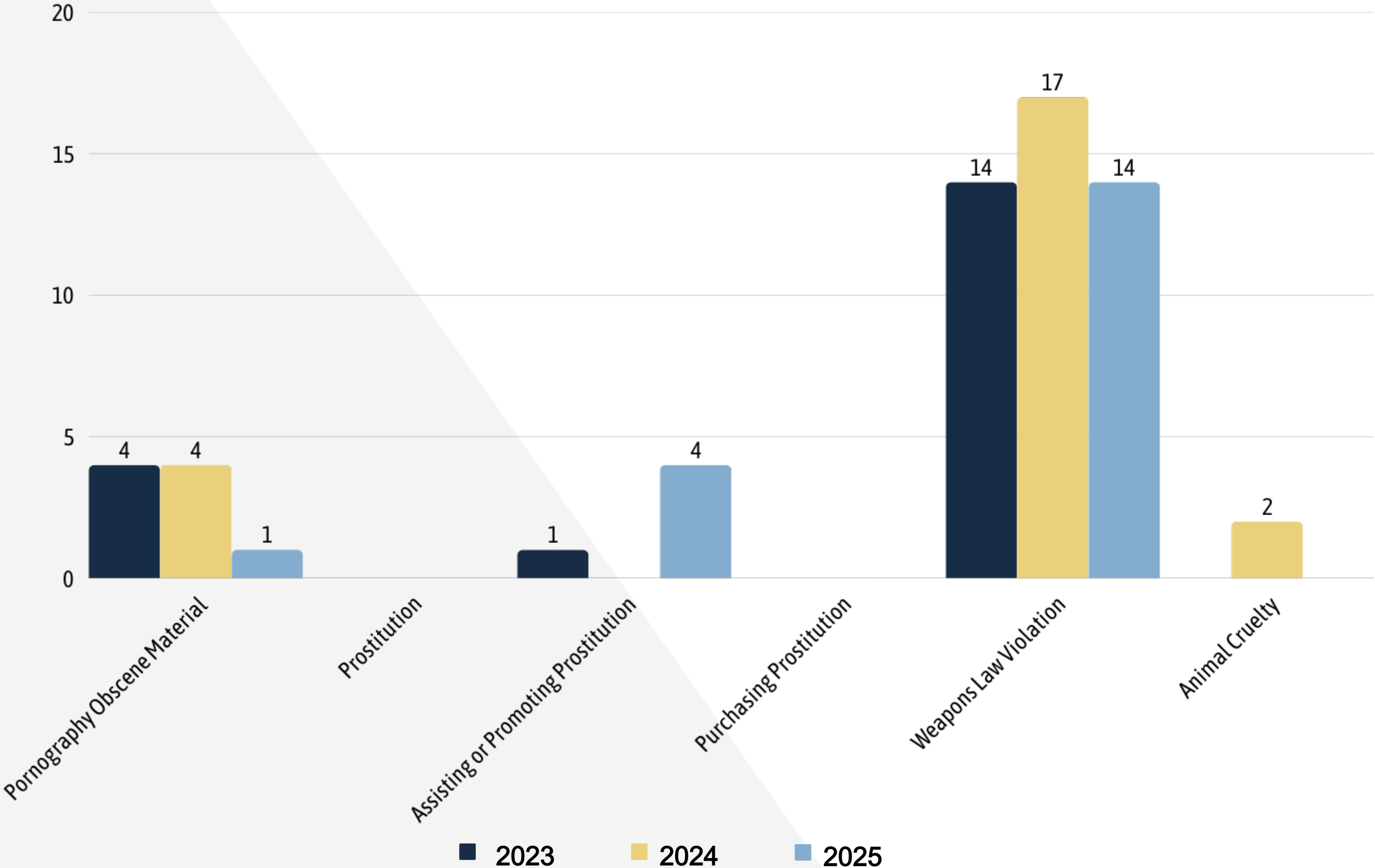
