Health Coverage Enrollment Assistance in San Mateo County for Adults and Children

Who is Eligible for Health Coverage Programs?

Low to mid income San Mateo County residents or SMMC patients can apply. Eligibility is based on income and family size:

- Adults who work and children with working parents may be eligible.
- Immigrants may also be eligible for some programs, regardless of immigration status.

Where is Application Assistance Available?

The Health Coverage Unit (HCU) is offering both in-person and phone application assistance. Monday through Friday** 8:30 AM - 5:00 PM **Appointments preferred, drop-ins welcomed**

What Do I Need to Provide for My Application?

- **Proof of home address in San Mateo County** A recent utility bill, billing statement, letter, or ID that has your address
- **Proof of income** If you have income, a recent employment pay stub, government check stub (unemployment or disability), or tax forms from the previous year are accepted.
- **Proof of identity** Any state ID card, ID from country of origin, or passport
- **Social Security Number or Tax ID Number (if applicable)**
- **Proof of resident status (for legal permanent residents only)** Residency card
- **Work Permit (if applicable)**
