***Instructions for Public Comment During Hybrid Meetings**

During hybrid meetings, members of the public may address the LGBTQIA+ Commission as follows:

***Written Comments:** Written public comments may be emailed in advance of the meeting. Please read the instructions carefully:

1. Your written comment should be emailed to tbeat@smcgov.org by 12 p.m. on the day of the meeting.
2. Your email should include the specific agenda item on which you are commenting or note that your comment concerns an item that is not on the agenda or is on the consent agenda.
3. Members of the public are limited to one comment per agenda item.
4. The length of the emailed comment should be commensurate with the one minute customarily allowed for verbal comments, which is approximately 150-200 words.
5. If your emailed comment is received by 12:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting, it will be provided to the LGBTQIA+ Commission. If emailed comments are received after 12:00p.m. on the day of the meeting, the staff will make every effort to either (i) provide such emailed comments to the LGBTQIA+ Commission, or (ii) read such emails or a summary thereof during the meeting.

***Spoken Comments:** In person Participation:

1. If you wish to speak, please fill out a speaker's slip located on the materials table. If you have anything that you wish distributed to the LGBTQIA+ Commission, please hand it to staff who will distribute the information to the members and staff.

Via Teleconference (Zoom):

1. The meeting may be accessed through Zoom online (see instructions above).
2. You may download the Zoom client or connect to the meeting using an internet browser. If using your browser, make sure you are using a current, up-to-date browser: Chrome 30+, Firefox 27+, Microsoft Edge 12+, Safari 7+. Certain functionality may be disabled in older browsers including Internet Explorer.
3. You will be asked to enter an email address and name. We request that you identify yourself by name as this will be visible online and will be used to notify you that it is your turn to speak.
4. When either Chair or staff calls for the item on which you wish to speak, click on "raise hand." Speakers will be notified shortly before they are called to speak.
