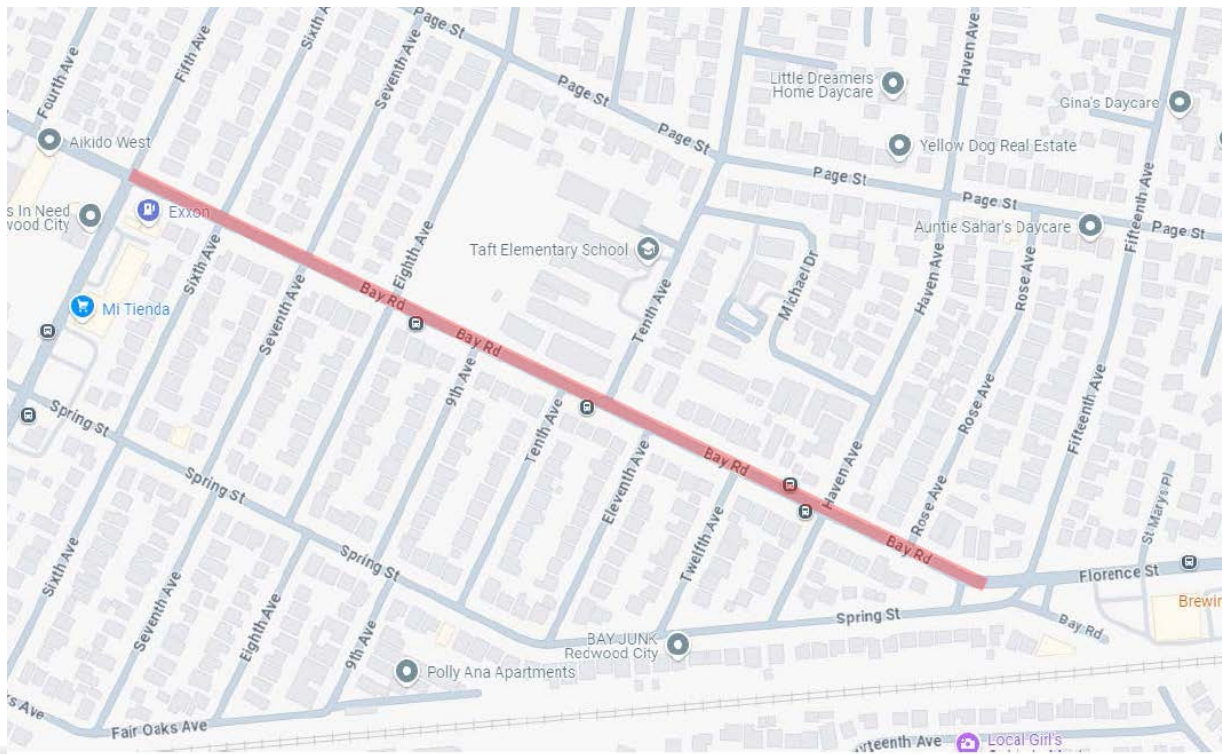

Bay Road Complete Streets Rehab (OBAG 3) Project

Location

The County of San Mateo, in partnership with the City of Redwood City, will design and construct the Project to improve conditions for all road users who use or cross Bay Road. The Project limits are from 5th Avenue and 15th Avenue/Spring Street.



Bay Road Complete Streets Rehab (OBAG 3) Project

About the Project

The project will include:

- Pedestrian crossing improvements at key intersections (such as 8th and Haven Avenues)
- New facilities for bicyclists (Class II bike lanes or Class IV separated bikeways)
- Sidewalk, curb and gutter repairs including ADA-compliant curb ramps
- Bus stop amenities (e.g. shelters, seating) and bus pads
- New traffic control at the Bay/Spring/15th intersection
- Pavement rehabilitation
- Green infrastructure
- Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) has transitioned the funding to City and will be taking the lead
- The Department is working with the City to finalize roles and responsibilities
- Design cannot start until agency agreement is secured
- City released Request for Proposal (RFP) on April 15, 2025, to select a design consultant that will lead the design efforts.
- The City has awarded the design contract.
- Design is anticipated to begin in January 2026.



2026 Pavement Preservation Project

Location

Miramar and Montara areas of the Unincorporated County

About the Project

The 2026 Pavement Preservation Project includes pavement repair, micro surfacing, restriping of pavement markings, and bicycle striping improvements of various streets in the unincorporated areas of San Mateo County. Approximately 15 miles of pavement preservation.

2026 Pavement Preservation Project

- The roads in this Project were reviewed against the ATP, LRSP and other adopted plans recommendations:
 - County will incorporate elements into this Project such as bike sharrows, high visibility crosswalks, ADA curb ramps, where feasible.
- Construction to start in Summer 2026
- Crack sealing of roads shall commence in Spring

Pescadero Area (Bean Hollow Road, Cloverdale Road, Pigeon Point Road, Butano Cut-Off, Stage Road, Alpine Road).

About the Project

Pavement repairs will be performed on these roads in Spring 2026 for chip sealing in Summer 2026.
