# CHANGES TO MEDI-CAL: NON-CITIZEN COVERAGE

## WHAT IS HAPPENING?

- Starting January 1, 2026, some adults will no longer be able to sign up for full Medi-Cal coverage.

## WHO IS AFFECTED?

- Adults ages 19 and older without qualifying immigration status

## WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

- Applications received on or after January 1, 2026, will only qualify for emergency or pregnancy Medi-Cal.
- If you already have Medi-Cal, you'll continue getting full coverage regardless of immigration status, as long as you renew on time and still qualify.

## WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- ✓ **Apply by December 31, 2025, to qualify for full Medi-Cal coverage!**
- ✓ Make sure your contact information is up to date and you renew on time
- ✓ If your Medi-Cal coverage stops because of late renewal or missing paperwork, you have 90 days to submit it and keep your full coverage.
