Process

- Prior to the expiration of a term, staff contacts the member to determine whether they are interested in serving another term.
- Members interested in reappointment submit a written request to staff.
- Staff forwards the request to the Clerk of the Board and the President of the Board of Supervisors for consideration.
- If approved, staff and the Clerk prepare a reappointment item for consideration by the Board of Supervisors.
- Upon Board approval, the member is reappointed to a new term.
- If the member does not seek reappointment, or if the reappointment is not approved, the seat becomes vacant and is opened for recruitment.

Next Steps

- Department has received notice from two of the three members who's terms are expired as of the development of this presentation.
- Department will forward the requests, along with other pertinent information to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, who passes it on to the Board of Supervisors
- Based on decision of the President of the Board, reappointments go to the Board of Supervisors as a future Board of Supervisor Meeting (August 11, 2026)
- Members will need to take Oath of Office before serving which can be scheduled with the Clerk of the Board
