5. If your emailed comment is received by 12:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting, it will be provided to the CSW. If emailed comments are received after 12:00p.m. on the day of the meeting, the staff will make every effort to either (i) provide such emailed comments to the CSW, or (ii) read such emails or a summary thereof during the meeting.
