

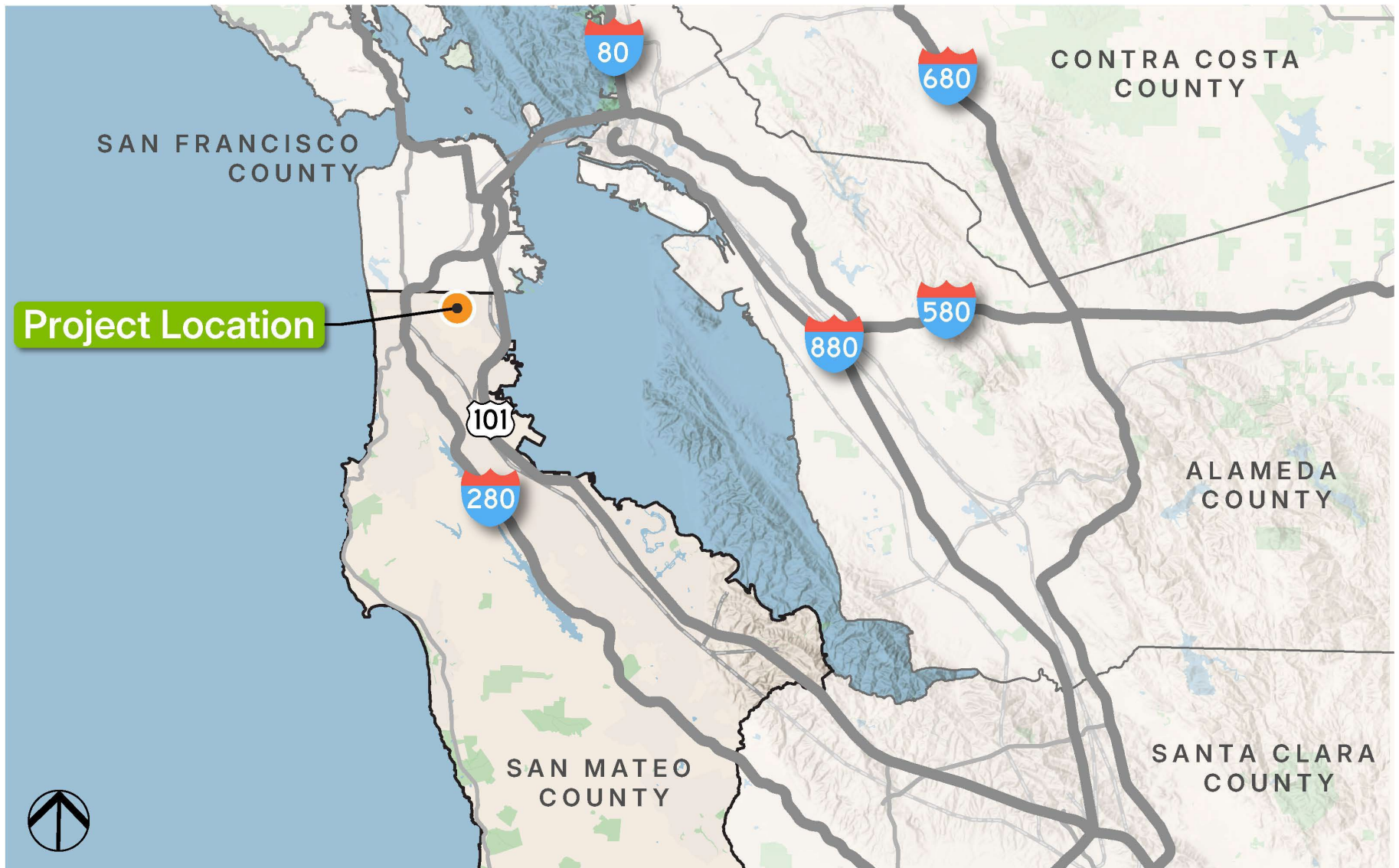

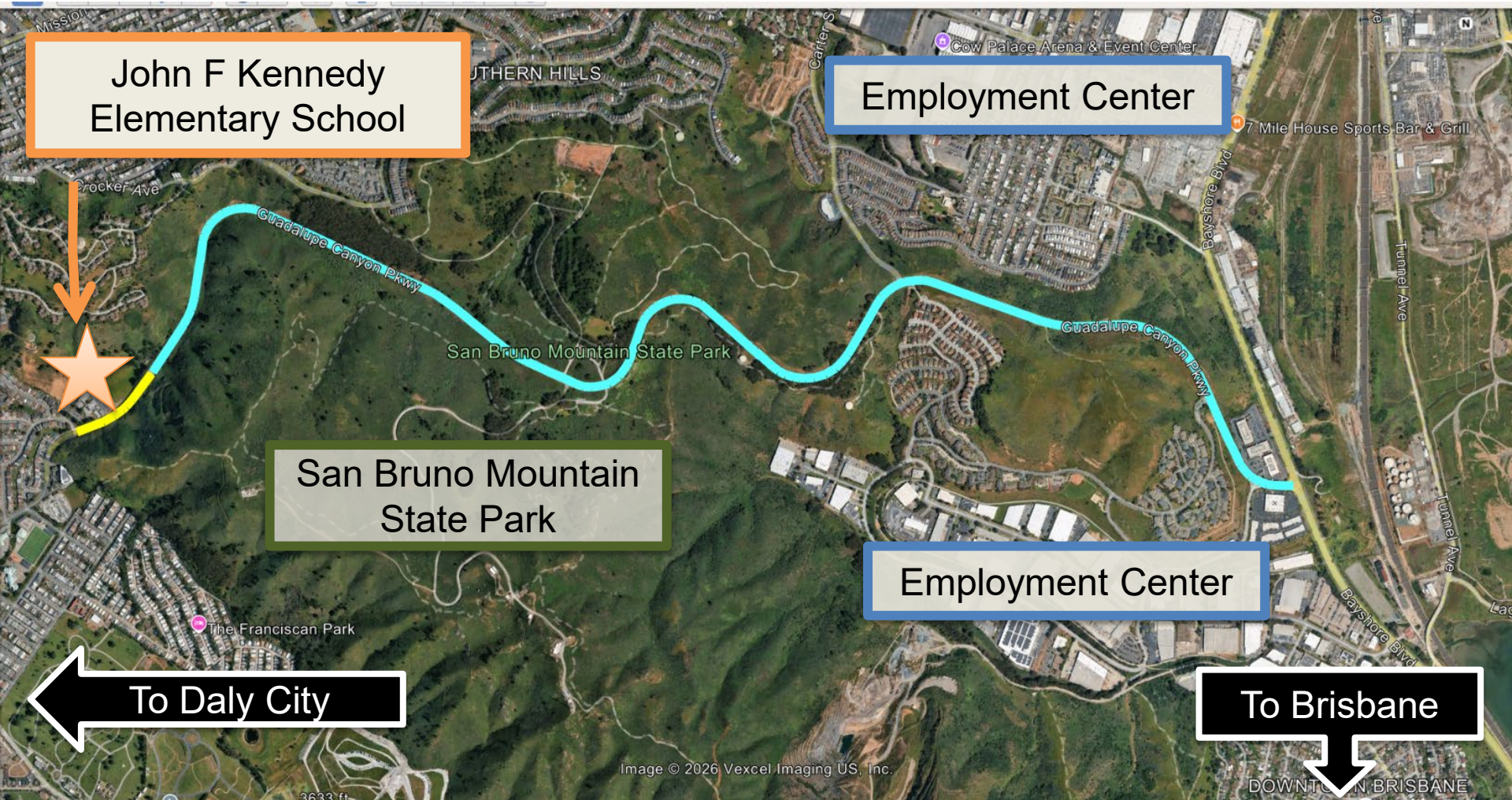

 - Unincorporated San Mateo County Active Transportation Plan



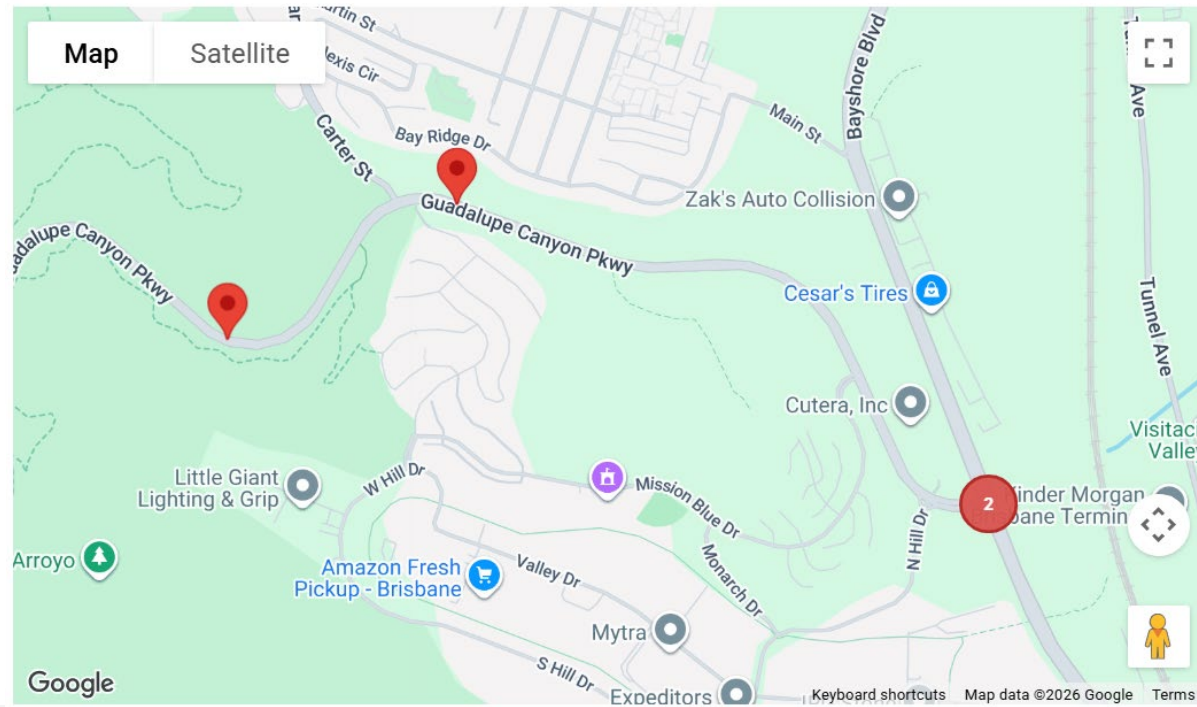
Project Background – Road Safety

- Project will address collision history on corridor between vehicles and bicyclists.
 - Three (3) vehicle-to-bicycle collisions in past five (5) years resulting in severe injuries

Project Background – Complete Streets

- Project designs for multiple modes:



- **Pedestrians:** Sidewalk on both sides of Guadalupe Canyon Parkway to serve school community events, student pick-up/drop off



- **Bicyclists:** Upgrade Buffered Class II Facility to Protected Class IV Facility



- **Personal Vehicles:** Parking on both sides of Guadalupe Canyon Road near the Elementary School for student pick-up/drop-off



- **School Buses:** Maintaining U-Turns & circulation for access surrounding the campus



- **Emergency Response Vehicles:** Maintains existing number of lanes for emergency events.

Project Background – State of Good Repair

- Includes grind and overlay for the westbound lanes in poor condition between Bayshore Blvd and Carter Street to extend the useful life of the existing pavement.

Project Background – Plan Bay Area Alignment

- T1: Operate and Maintain the Existing System
- T9: Build a Complete Streets Network
- EN6: Expand Urban Greening in Communities
- EN9: Expand Transportation Demand Management Initiatives

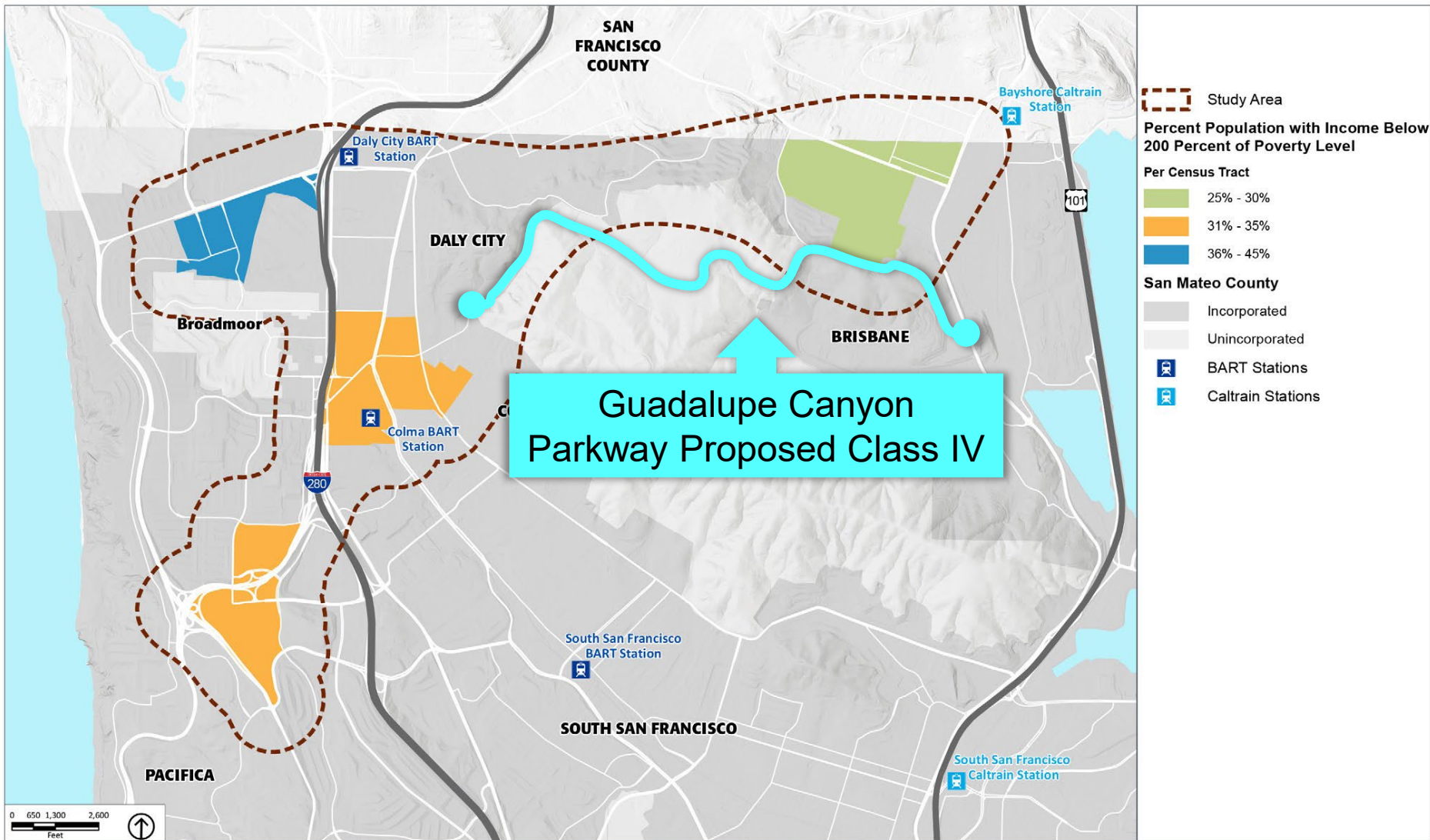


Figure 2-6 Population in Poverty

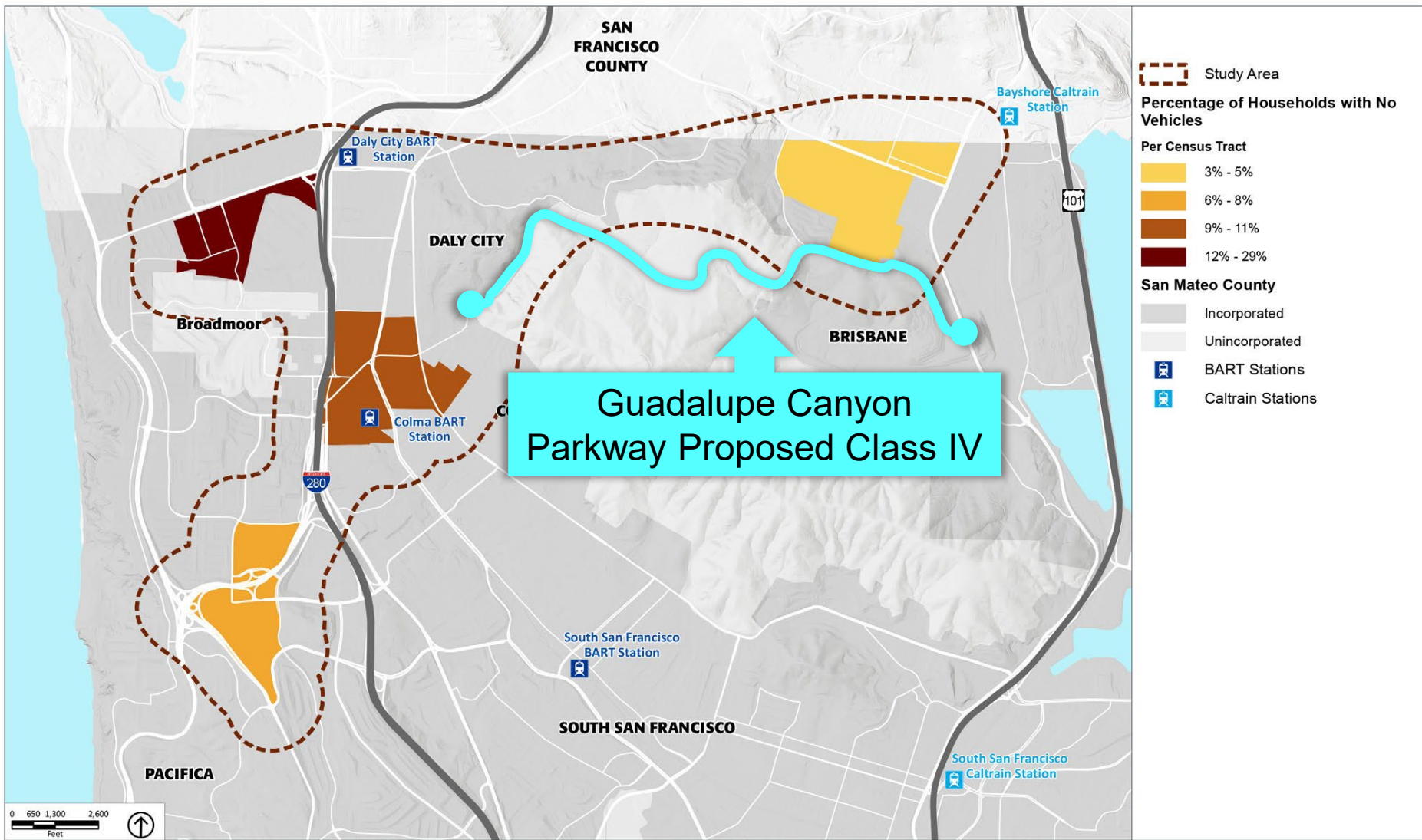
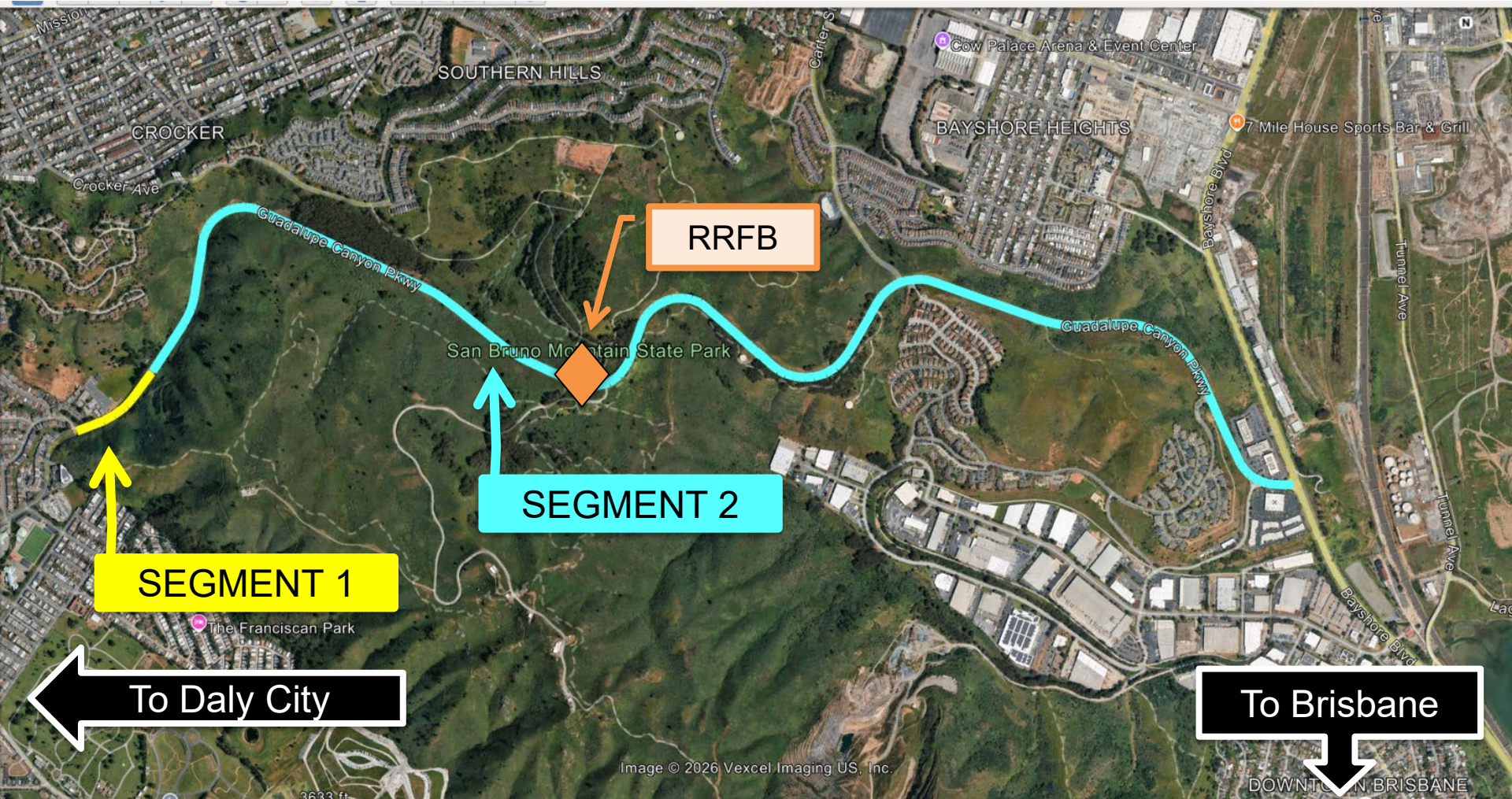


Figure 2-9 Household Vehicle Availability

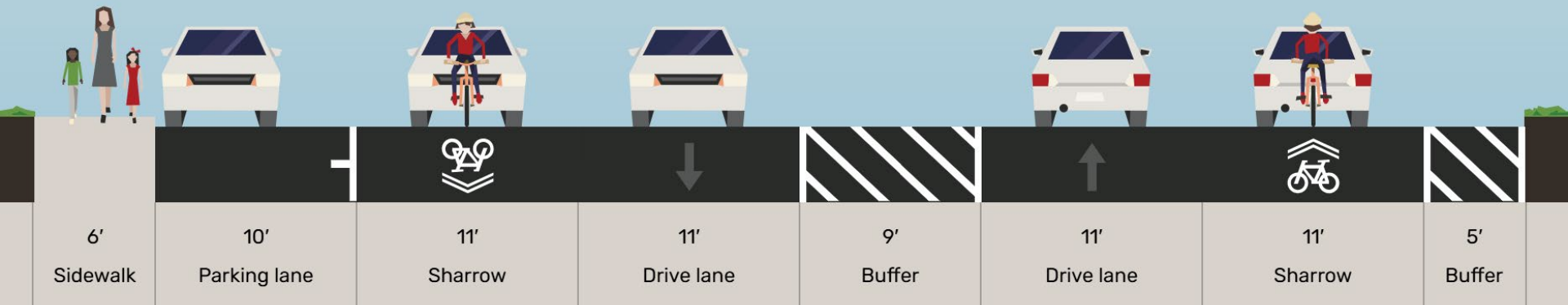

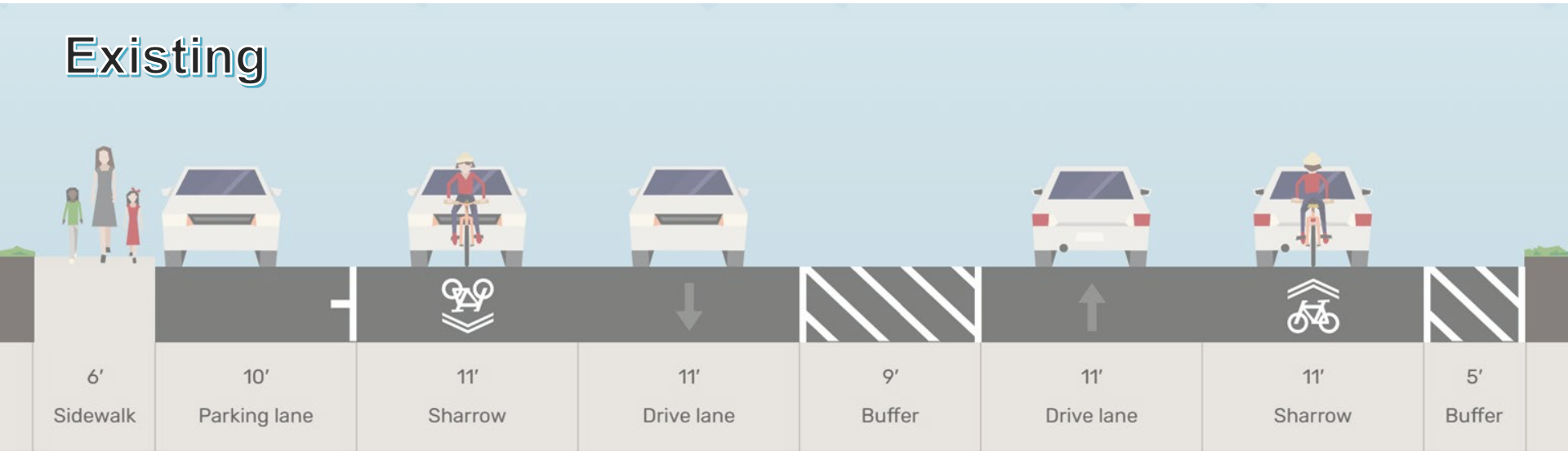
SEGMENT 1 AT PRICE ST

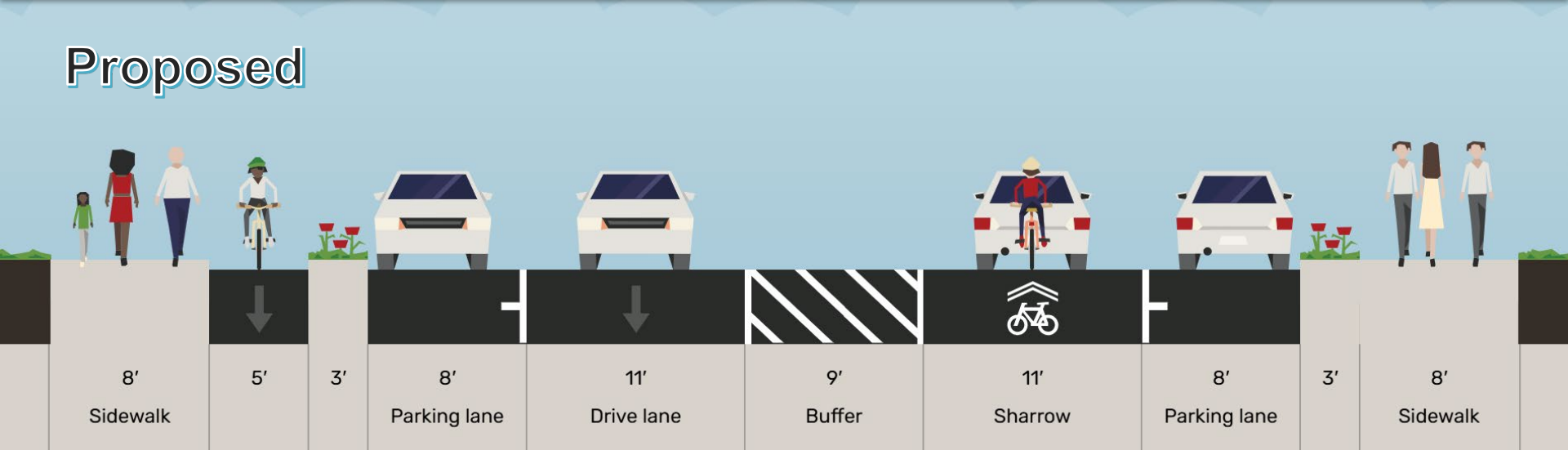


SEGMENT 1 AT PRICE ST

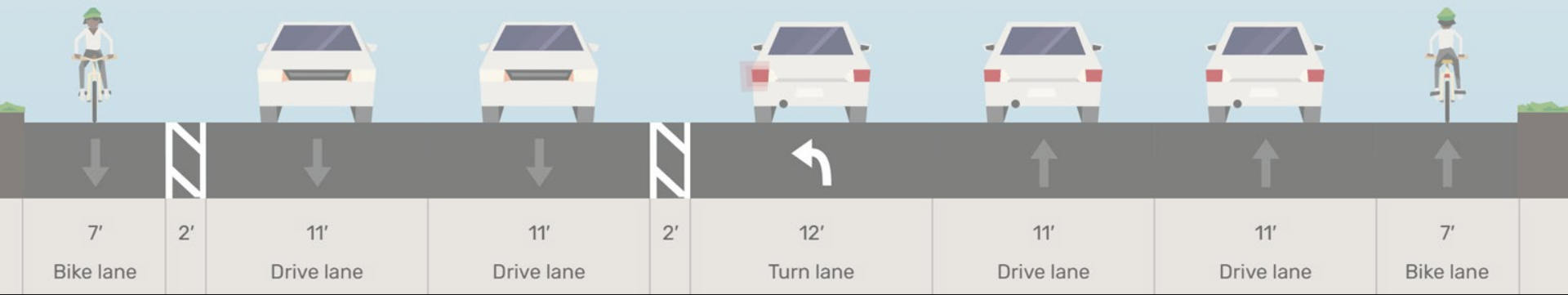
SEGMENT 1 AT U-TURN

Existing

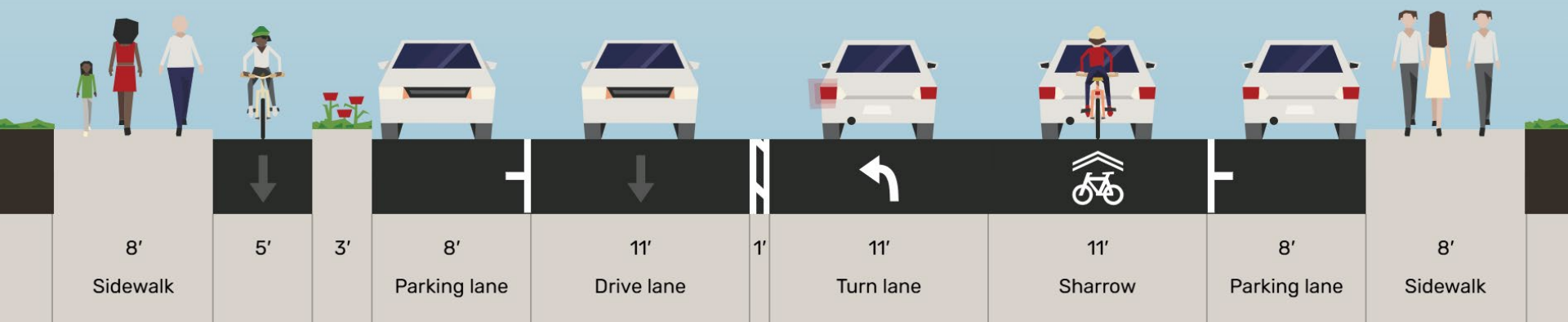


SEGMENT 1 AT U-TURN

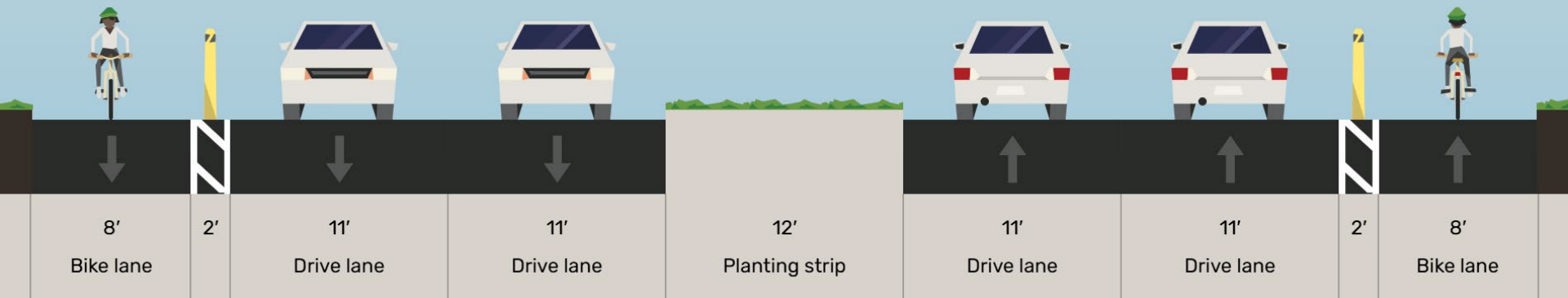
