Get free entry to San Mateo County Parks through the Mariposa Program

You may be eligible for a free San Mateo County Park pass through the Mariposa Program, a partnership between the San Mateo County Parks Department and Human Services Agency (HSA).

Where can I use the park pass?

The park pass is good for 12 months, and covers the \$6 vehicle entrance fee to these San Mateo County Parks:

- San Bruno Mountain in Brisbane
- Junipero Serra Park in San Bruno
- Coyote Point Recreation Area in San Mateo
- Huddart Park in Woodside
- San Pedro Valley Park in Pacifica
- Sam McDonald Park in Loma Mar
- Memorial Park in Loma Mar

Am I eligible for this program?

San Mateo County households with at least one resident who is enrolled in these programs are eligible for a park pass:

- Medi-Cal
- CalFresh
- CalWORKS
- San Mateo County Access and Care for Everyone (ACE)

How can I request a free park pass?

For renewals, please contact HSA two to four weeks prior to pass expiration.

If you're not enrolled in one of the programs listed above, you can still get free entry to a San Mateo County Park if:

- You check out a park pass at a San Mateo County Library
- You are a veteran and show proof of veteran status
- You are a senior (62+) (free entry Monday–Friday, non-holidays)
- Your vehicle displays disabled plates/placards
