On July 29, 2026, the Housing and Community Development Committee (HCDC) will convene a Public Hearing to consider proposals submitted for Affordable Housing Fund (AHF) funding received in response to the County's Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA), released on April 20, 2026, and posted on the Department of Housing's website at <https://www.smcgov.org/housing/ahf14-nofa>.

This NOFA, which is Round 14 of the County's Affordable Housing Fund ("AHF 14.0"), is targeted to three types of affordable housing projects: New Construction Multifamily Affordable Rental Housing projects; Multifamily Re-Syndication-Rehabilitation projects for existing deed-restricted multifamily affordable rental housing developments; and Multifamily New Construction Affordable First-Time Homeownership projects.

The NOFA provided the opportunity to compete for approximately \$24,247,311.00 in Measure K funds, \$100,000 in County Impact Fees (for unincorporated San Mateo County only), and \$5,000,000.00 in Mental Health Services Act funds.

The HCDC recommendations, together with Department of Housing staff comments and recommendations, will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval. Final approval of projects to receive AHF funding, and funding amounts, will be made by the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors.
