**THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS
HAS PROVIDED RESPONSES (R) TO THE QUESTIONS BELOW**

- Q1. Does the County have a schedule for the chip seal showing how many days the County expects the anticipated need for distributor trucks applying the emulsion and how many hours per shift they will be operating?
- R1. The anticipated schedule for the chip seal work is September 8 through September 11. Anticipated work shifts may vary between 8 and 12 hours per day.*
- Q2. Should the County forces exceed the schedule how the contractor be compensated for the additional hours of work?
- R2. In the event that the schedule is exceeded any additional compensation shall follow Standard Caltrans Specification, Section 4-1.05.*
- Q3. Does the County have a break down of the anticipated need for emulsion at each location? Which is important to calculate freight.
- R3. The anticipated amount of emulsion required will be based off the total tonnage under Bid Item #2, Rejuvenating Polymer Modified Asphaltic Emulsion.*
