- ❖ Call will be released soon, likely in September

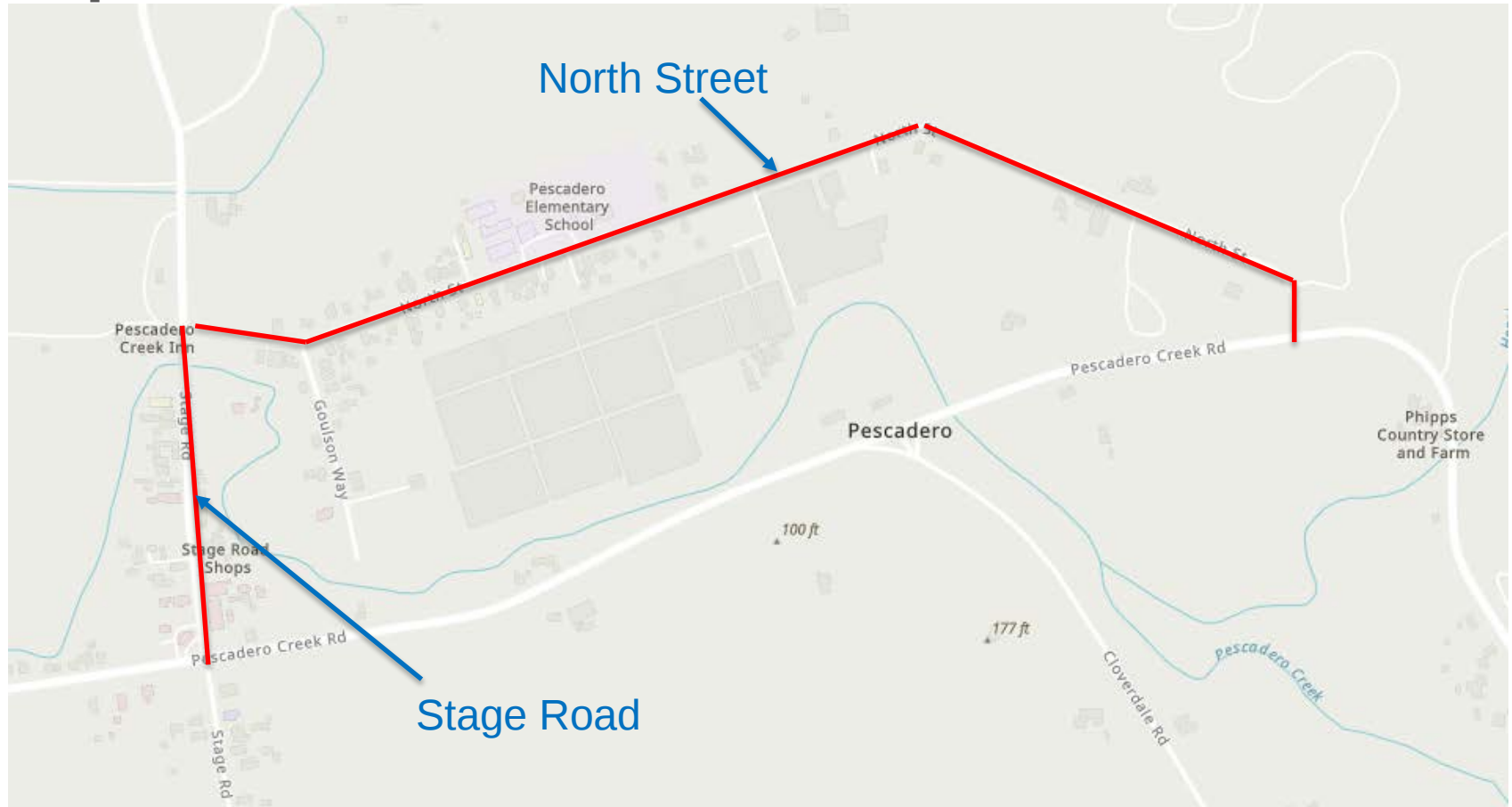
Review of Potential Projects

Pescadero – North Street/Stage Road Improvements

- ❖ Close pedestrian gaps between North Street and Stage Road
- ❖ Implement Class III Bike Boulevard on Stage Road from North Street to Pescadero Creek Road
- ❖ Implement Class III Bike Boulevard on North Street from Stage Road to Pescadero Creek Road
- ❖ Included in Active Transportation Plan

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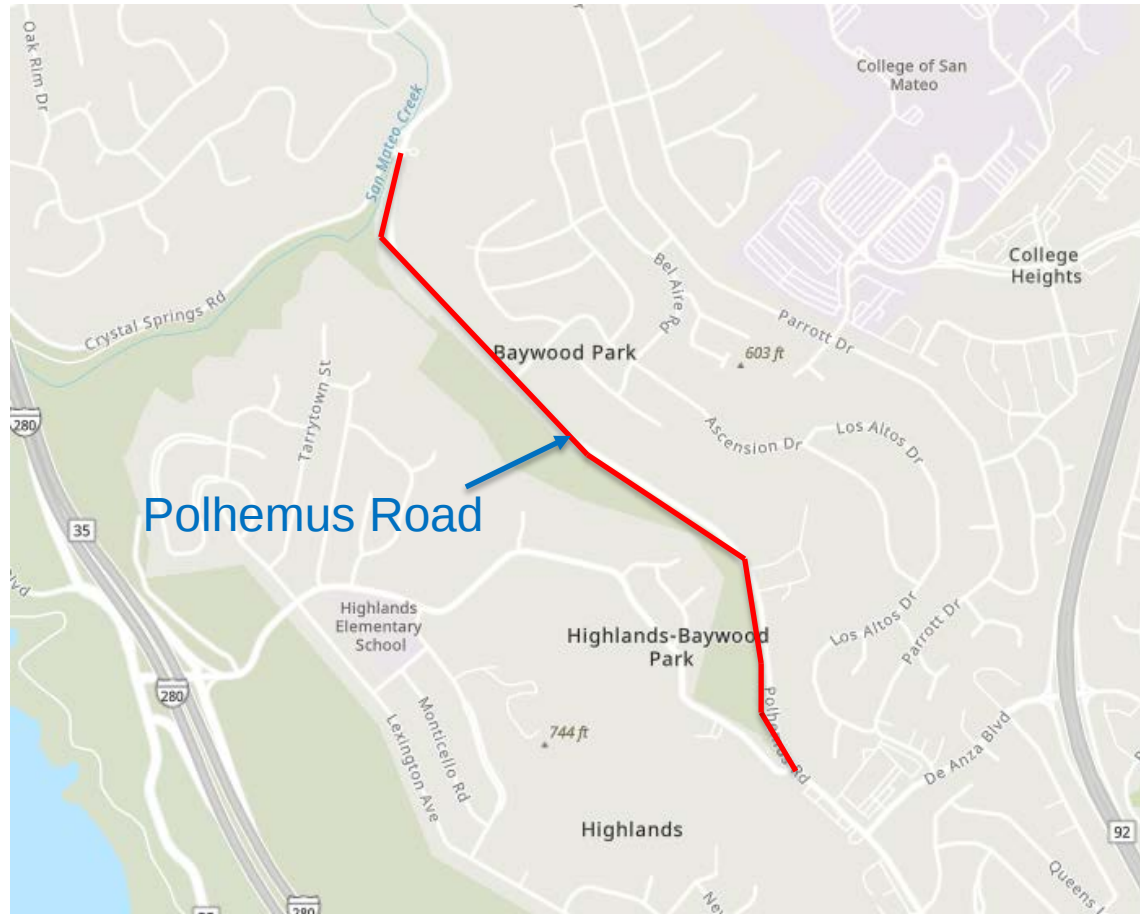

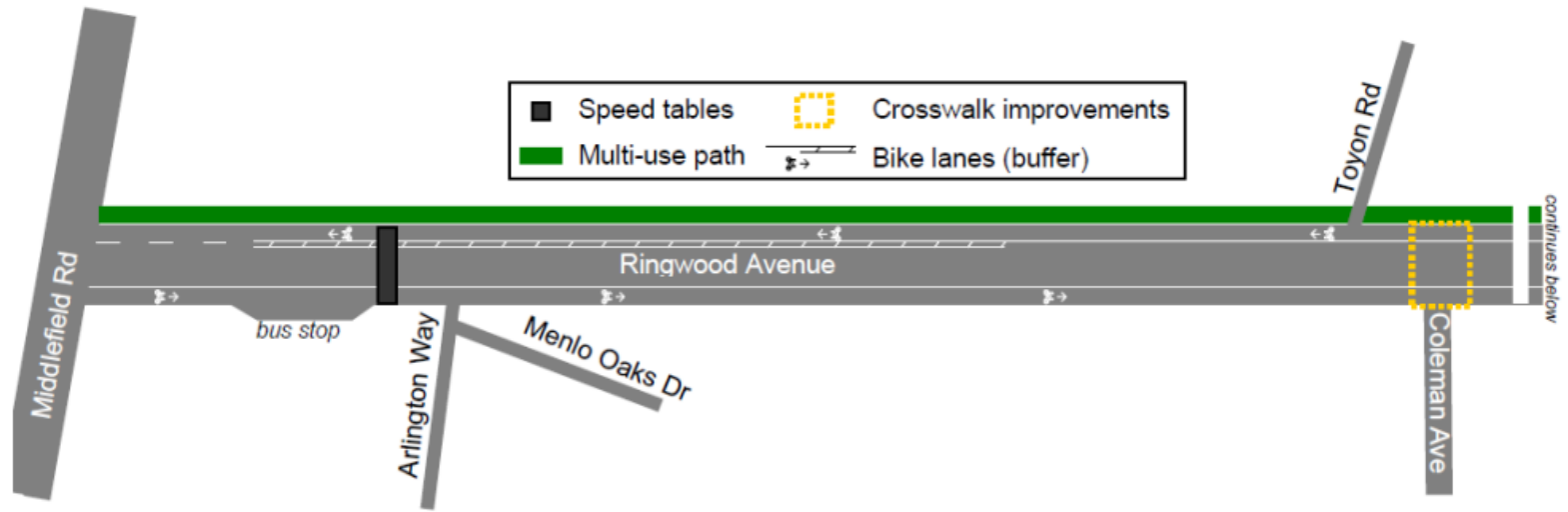
Review of Potential Projects

- Included in the Active Transportation Plan

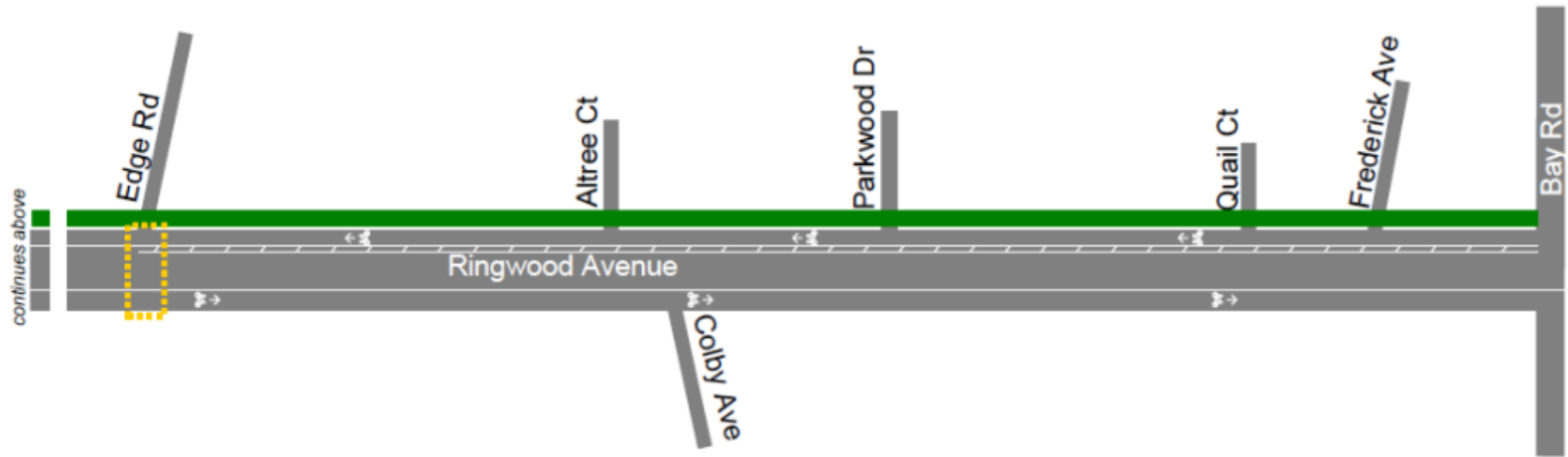

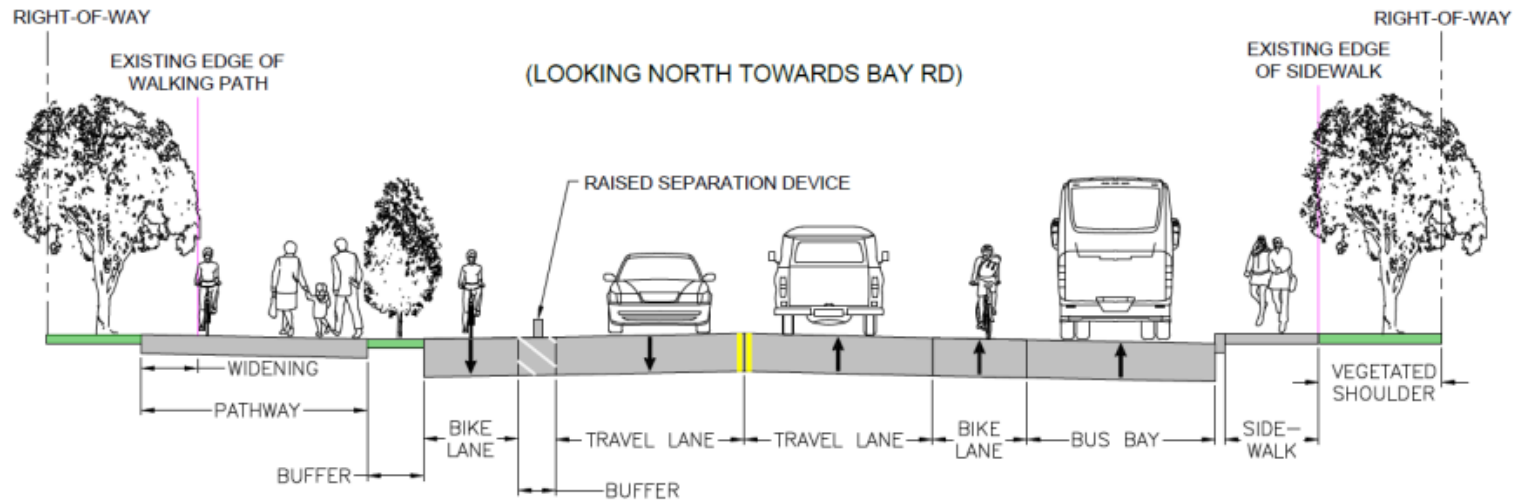

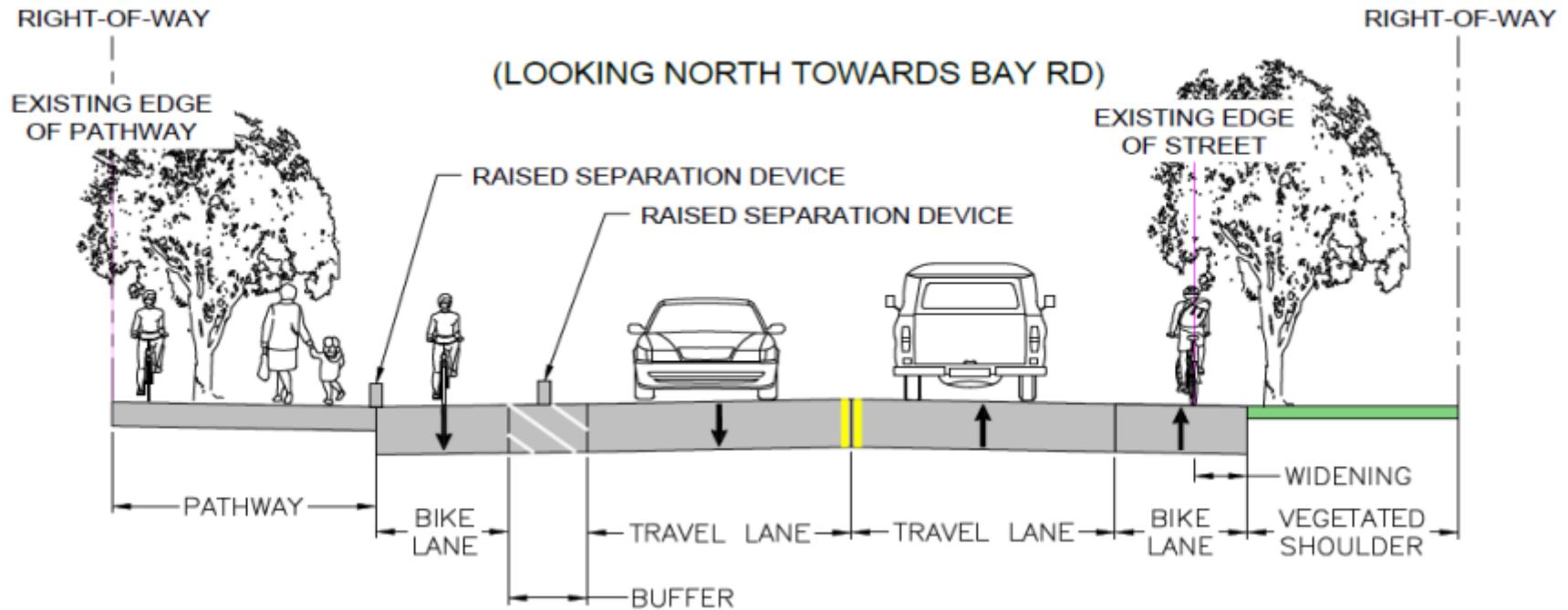
