- Will submit for State Active Transportation Program (ATP Cycle 8)

# Active 101 South County Priority Corridor Projects: Bay Road Complete Streets Improvements

- On August 6, 2026, the SMCTA Board supported awarding \$750,000 plus \$100,000 in Technical Assistance.
- Final award is pending approval during September SCMTA Board meeting.
- Project will include curb ramps, bike lanes, high-visibility crosswalks, pedestrian hybrid beacons.

- Marsh Road from Middlefield Road to Interchange
- County, Town of Atherton, and City of Menlo Park

- On August 6, 2026, the SMCTA Board supported awarding \$1,000,000 plus \$150,000 in Technical Assistance
- Final award is pending approval during September SCMTA Board meeting.
