Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee

President of the Board of Supervisors announced that applications are being accepted for appointment to the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee.

There are two (2) vacancies: One member (1) representing Safe Routes to Schools; and One (1) representing At-Large Member. To be eligible for this recruitment, applicants must be a resident of Supervisorial Districts 1, 2, 3 or 5 in San Mateo County. District 4 is fully represented at this time. This seven-member committee advises the Board of Supervisors on funding, projects, programs and policies related to improving and increasing bicycling and walking transportation, primarily within the County's unincorporated communities.

The Committee establishes the time and place of its regular meetings and meets at least 4 times a year unless otherwise determined by a majority vote of the Committee, currently on the 3rd Thursdays of even-numbered months at 6:00 PM in Manzanita Hall, 500 County Center, Redwood City.

Deadline for receipt of applications is Friday, August 21, 2026 at 5 p.m.
