were served in shelter programs during this quarter



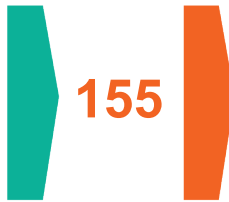

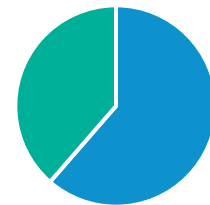
Households Moved Into Permanent Housing In the Past 12 Months
