Their programs include:

- **Home Sharing Program:** helps match individuals seeking housing with people who have a room or Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) to rent
- **Self Sufficiency Program:** provides housing assistance and support services to low-income parents or transitional age foster youth
- **Housing Readiness Program:** empowers San Mateo County older adult (62+) community members to navigate our complex local housing landscape
