1st Construction Notice

Dear Residents:

Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc. has been contracted by the County of San Mateo to perform the **Reconstruction of Seventh Avenue from Middlefield Road to Edison Way** in your neighborhood. The scope of work consists of installation of concrete valley gutters, Concrete Chicanes and excavating, grinding. Cement treating & paving of the roadway. In addition, we will be adjusting utility castings, and installing street markings and stripes.

The working hours for the project are 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday. There will be no weekend work. This work is scheduled to begin on your street May 14th and end August 7th.

"No parking, Tow Away" signs will be posted 48 hours prior to the actual days of work in the specific areas of the streets being affected, showing where parking will be prohibited. The signs will also indicate the dates and times when no parking will be allowed. When the areas being worked in are completed, the signs will be removed. Do not park in these areas until the signs have been removed. If weather or mechanical problems cause delays to the project, the dates for these parking restrictions and street closures may need to be amended to complete the work in certain areas.

Traffic flow will be impeded and/or detoured during construction hours. We ask that you minimize your trips through the construction area. Access to a limited amount of driveways may be affected on certain days where street closures will take effect. Notification will be provided if certain driveway access is limited. Should you plan to use your vehicle during the construction periods when on-street parking has been prohibited, please make arrangements to park vehicles on adjacent streets.
