



## The 7<sup>th</sup> Mailing, Email and Telephone Calls

- A 7<sup>th</sup> mailing, which will include the paper questionnaire, has been scheduled for late August, early September. It will go to households in lowest-responding census tracts.
- Based on the COVID 19 Pulse Survey model, we have also sent email to households in low self-responding areas with a reminder to respond to the census.
- Census Enumerators, aka Census Takers are also attempting to contact households that have not taken their census via landlines and/or mobile numbers.




## Bay Area Census Operations Update

- ➤ Group Quarters Enumeration: July 1 September 3
- Residents being counted in group-setting residences, such as skilled-nursing facilities and college dormitories.
- ➤ Mobile Questionnaire Assistance (MQA): July 13 September 18
- Census workers assisting and/or counting people at high foot traffic locations, when it's safe to do so.
- Non-Response Follow-Up (NRFU): August 11
- Census takers have been knocking on doors of households that have not self-responded by then. Residents will STILL be able to self-respond while this operation is underway.
- Service-Based Enumeration (SBE)/Targeted Non-Sheltered Outdoor Locations (TNSOL): September 22-24
- Census workers will be counting those who are experiencing homelessness at shelters, transitional housing and outdoor locations.
- > Self-response deadline (end of data collection period): September 30







## How to Identify a Census Taker

The census taker will have an ID badge that includes:

- their name
- their photograph
- Department of Commerce watermark, and
- an expiration date.
- They will have an official bag and electronic device, such as laptop or smartphone, bearing the Census Bureau logo.
- Census takers will conduct their work between 9 am and 9 pm.
