Your Voice is Essential!

By now everyone should have received your **2020 Census** questionnaire in the mail. If you have NOT, it's ok, you have until October 31st to complete it.

What is it?

- Every ten years the federal government is required to count everyone living in the United States.
- The U.S. Census Bureau collects information from every residence about who is living there and basic information about each member of the household.
- This information is combined into statistics that are used to make important policy and budget decisions.

What will be Asked?

Basic information will be collected about each household, such as:

- number of people living there
- home ownership
 phone number

- phone number

As well as for each person:

- name
 sex
- sex
 age
- race/ethnicity

Who Gets Counted?

EVERYONE! Every single person living in the United States should be counted. Make sure you count everyone living there including:

- All children and parents
- Extended family members like grandparents, aunts/uncles and cousins
- Non-family members such as friends, roommates or workmates

Why is it Important?

- Federal funding for critical community programs like:
- food assistance, healthcare, emergency services, education, transportation and more
- Political representation
- Redistricting

Is it Confidential?

By law, information you give on the census form is confidential.

The Census Bureau takes many steps to protect your personal information and does not share household or individual data.




Why aren't Latino Businesses Applying?


1. Have you received information regarding small business loans and grants for businesses effected by COVID-19?

2. If you received information, did you apply?




