








Special Circumstances

- Fireworks show canceled the City of Redwood City






Calls for Service




On July 4th, 2020, we received a total of 48 calls for service related to fireworks in North Fair Oaks. 11 more calls for service than the previous year.

The total number of calls related to fireworks represent an increase of 30% in comparison to calls received in 2019.

The activity detected by ShotSpotter on July 4th and the eve of July 5th, 2020 for the area of North Fair Oaks was 6 firecracker incidents.


Shot Spotter Activity

Field Operations

- 2 Deputies and 2 Sergeants were assigned to work the firework suppression detail in the North Fair Oaks area of Unincorporated San Mateo County.
- Briefing was conducted in the Headquarters Patrol briefing room at 1600 hours and the special detail team dispersed to patrol the designated "hot spots".
- This year we noticed large crowds of people gathering to watch the fireworks. We experienced a higher amount of activity in the vicinity.












Hot Spots



- The hot spot areas consisted of Halsey Avenue between Hampshire Avenue, Warrington Avenue, and Stanford Avenue.
- Several residents were conducting their own traffic control and blocking the streets to allow for illegal fireworks to be ignited and making it difficult
 - offenders.

Enforcement

- The highest number of fireworks activity was estimated between 8:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m.
- During this time deputies wrote 20 citations and confiscated a considerable amount of mortar, P-100, roman candles, and bottle rockets among other illegal fireworks. Our Bomb Unit took possession of these fireworks.



Lessons Learned

We have already started the planning for New Year's Eve 2021 and July 4, 2021.

We need additional technology to assist us with apprehension of these offenders.

We have learned that we need to conduct additional investigations prior to each event.

There is always room for improvement and work more closely with the community.
