### Defined application window, <u>NOT</u> first-come, first-served



- Incomplete applications will NOT be processed and ineligible applications will NOT be considered -

### Pre-Application Opened on Monday, August 16 at 8:00AM

#### **Pre-Application Form Includes:**

- Name of business
- Establishment address
- Name of applicant
- Applicant email address
- Applicant phone number
- Applicant's relationship to establishment (sole proprietor, co-owner, managing partner of LLC, principal, other)
- % of establishment application owns (e.g. 50%, 100%, etc.)
- Attestations (not received other funding)

OPTIONAL - Ownership Demographics of Applying Owner, Partner, or Principal (for *data collection* <u>only</u> & will <u>NOT</u> be used in the selection process)

- Woman, minority, LGBTQ+, veteran-owned
- Race
- Gender
- Age



**Pre-application available in:** 

**English, Spanish, Chinese, or Tagalog** 

If selected, applicants must be *prepared* to provide the following documents: (those items are <u>NOT</u> required to complete this application):

- IRS Form W9
- IRS Tax Returns 2019 & 2020 Form 1040 (including Schedule C or Form 1065)
- City/Town Business License (if applicable)
- Photo ID of establishment owner(s)/partners/principal(s)

## **Categories of Potential Applicants**







Will provide grants of up to \$10,000 each to qualifying establishments:



# NO COUNTY, STATE, FEDERAL FUNDING

 Business\* <u>has not received</u> a County small business grant or State or Federal small business COVID recovery grant or loan in the past 12 months



#### **IMPACTED BY COVID-19**

- Demonstrate that the business was negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic by providing completed tax returns from 2019 and 2020 (including IRS Schedule C or Form 1065)
- Lawfully operated\*\* prior to March 11, 2020, when a local state of emergency was proclaimed due to the COVID-19 pandemic



#### **ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY**

- Had a gross income of \$120,000 or less in 2019
- 10 or fewer employees in 2019;
- Fully compliant with applicable regulations
- Applicant must possess and present copy of government-issued photo id

The application portal opened on Monday, August 16th at 8:00AM and will remain open until Tuesday, September 7th at 5:00PM

<sup>\*</sup>Currently occupy a physical business space in San Mateo County (if the business is a franchise, is independently owned and operated by a County resident, or 50% or more of the franchisee ownership must be comprised of County residents)

<sup>\*\*</sup>Establishments that have changed ownership since March 11, 2020, and otherwise meet the Program criteria above are eligible.

### What Types of Businesses **DO NOT** Qualify for the Grant?







Applicants will be <u>ineligible</u> for a grant from the Program under the following circumstances:



**Incomplete applications** 



Failure to meet the eligibility criteria outlined



They are a non-profit entity



The applicant's establishment has received or been approved for a grant from any of the following programs:

- Small business relief program managed by Renaissance Entrepreneurship Center, approved by the Board of Supervisors on October 20, 2020 (Resolution 077791)
- San Mateo County Strong Fund Small Business Grant administered by the Community Fund, approved by the Board of Supervisors on November 10, 2020 (Resolution 077828)
  - Recipients of grants from <u>earlier</u> San Mateo County Strong grant programs are eligible for the Program
- San Mateo County Restaurant, Brewery & Winery Grant Program
- San Mateo County Technology Grant
- Any other Federal or State COVID Relief loans or grants, such as
  - U.S. Small Business Administration *Paycheck Protection Program*
  - U.S. Small Business Administration COVID-19
     Economic Injury Disaster Loan
  - California Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant Program




