

Happy New Year!

Happy New Year! It truly was a pleasure to serve you and your family this last year and we look forward to seeing and working with you in 2018.

Here are just a few highlights of 2017:

From January 1st to December 31, 2017, total benefits claims awarded were 770, of which a total of **\$5,646,760.00** was issued to county veterans. From these, **\$299,668.71** will continue to be issued on a monthly basis. Additionally, sixty-eight State College Fee waivers were issued with an estimated **\$383,124.00** in savings to student dependent of service connected disabled veterans.

Also in 2017, we took thirty-two different approaches to connect or reconnect with veterans such as emails, letters (as this one), and or physical events. From these, we linked with 13,410 veterans and as a result, we saw 2,831 veterans or family members in our office. Of these, 1212 were first time clients. Additionally, 178 County Veteran IDs were issued in 2017.

As we welcome the New Year, I want you to know our staff is fully dedicated to assist you in any way we can. If you served, you earned! Let us help you connect with and receive the benefits you deserve. Happy and Healthy New Year to you and your family.


