Item: Information Sharing

Maria from Star Vista distributed a flyer on the Differential Response Resource Line.

Star Vista CAPS Program continues to seek a full time Spanish speaking clinician.

Star Vista is also hiring a bilingual clinician and 2 bilingual case managers.

Item: Issue Sharing

Star Vista raised the issue of the challenge for their clients being able to afford Mental Health Services. This was discussed and suggestions were made for some short-term solutions.

Item: CAPC Summit Debrief

There was consensus that the Resource Fair was the most valuable part of the event. Several people raised the issue of the location and time of the event being inaccessible to families. Many families need public transportation and are working during the week so they would not be able to attend.

The group discussed the possibility of holding an event for families and children next April for Child Abuse Prevention Month. Several ideas were brought up. This type of event would be labor-intensive and would require a commitment on the part of the CAPC membership. Discussions will continue; and plans for raising awareness will be developed.
