The Dredged Material Management Office (DMMO) is an interagency group comprised of representatives from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission, the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board, the California State Lands Commission, and state and federal wildlife agencies. At the meeting on May 17, 2017, the DMMO completed its review of the sediment test results presented in the document prepared by Haley and Aldrich, Inc. entitled, "Results of Chemical, Physical and Biological Testing of Sediments from the Coyote Point Marina," dated May 2017. The test results are for the approximately 52,000 cubic yards of sediment proposed to be dredged to a design depths of -8, -10, and -12 feet mean lower low water (MLLW), plus an overdepth allowance of 1 foot, from the Coyote Point Marina (Marina) located in San Mateo, San Mateo County, California.

The members of the DMMO are recommending to their respective agency's management that the sediment proposed for dredging from the Marina, as characterized in the above-referenced document, is suitable for unconfined aquatic disposal at the Alcatraz Dredged Material Disposal Site (SF-11).

Also, please be advised that this letter does not constitute an authorization to proceed with your dredge project. You must first obtain appropriate Federal, State and local authorizations and provide all appropriate notifications.
