In all other respects, the RFP Moving Services General Facilities shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

A. RESPONSES (R) TO THE QUESTIONS (Q) INCLUDING ANY MODIFICATIONS BASED ON THE RESPECTIVE QUESTION(S). SOME SIMILAR QUESTIONS ARE GROUPED AND SIMPLIFIED.

Q1 Will the requested scope of services be subject to local signatory/union requirements? If so - are non-union firms permitted to submit proposals?

R1 Per Section II, 2.4 Prevailing Rates, "Contractor is required to comply with state prevailing wage law, Chapter 1 of Part 7 of Division 2 of the Labor Code, commencing with Section 1720 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations, Chapter 8, Subchapter 3, commencing with Section 16000, for any "public works" as that term is defined in the submit proposals.

Q2 Since a hard copy is required - is the County accepting FedEx (overnight courier) deliveries?

R2 Yes

Q3 Would the County like a copy of our current schedule of fees, in addition to the requested price proposal?

R3 Yes, the schedule of fees is the price proposal.

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Q4 In reviewing the RFP, it appears that the certification requirements presented in Section II, Part 2.2, Item 2. C. may require revision.

As written, it requires: Certified Welding Inspector (CWI), Non-Destructive Testing (NDT), Ultrasound Testing and Magnetic Particle Testing (UT-MT) Inspector certified by the American Welding Society (AWS).

I believe this item should be as follows:

c. Welding inspections by a Certified Welding Inspector (CWI) certified by the American Welding Society (AWS), and Non-Destructive Testing (NDT) Ultrasound Testing and Magnetic Particle Testing (UT-MT) by an American Society for Nondestructive Testing (ASNT) Level II Inspector.

R4 Section II, Part 2.2, Item 2. C. should be updated to reflect to following changes: "Certified Welding Inspector (CWI), Non-Destructive Testing (NDT), Ultrasound Testing and Magnetic Particle Testing (UT-MT) Inspector certified by the American Welding Society (AWS)" shall be edited to read, "Welding inspections by a Certified Welding Inspector (CWI) certified by the American Welding Society (AWS), and Non-Destructive Testing (NDT) Ultrasound Testing and Magnetic Particle Testing (UT-MT) by an American Society for Nondestructive Testing (ASNT) Level II Inspector"

Q5 On page 7, 3.2 D (1) instructs to place all cost and pricing data in a separate sealed envelope clearly marked "PRICE PROPOSAL" whereas 3.3 A. (1) allows electronic submission.

3.3 A. (7) Proposal Format includes pricing.

R5 Please attach the price proposal as a separate file in the electronic submission, together with the standard proposal.

Q6 3.3 A. (1) instructs to state proposer name, RFP title and number in each filename. The RFP title is too long and may corrupt the PDF file.
