

## SAN CARLOS AIRPORT VEHICLE OPERATING RULES and POLICIES

- 1. Motor vehicles shall be operated in a proper and safe manner in accordance with Airport rules and regulations as well as all state and county laws.
- 2. Security gate codes are confidential and are not to be given to unauthorized personnel.
- 3. All vehicles shall remain clear of the Aircraft Operating Area (as marked on the airport by a solid yellow line parallel a dashed yellow line) except as authorized by the Airport Manager. No vehicles except ones having permission from the Airport Manager and twoway radio clearance from the FAA control tower may operate on any runway or taxiway.
- 4. All vehicles shall yield the right-of-way to aircraft.
- 5. When on airport property, in no event should vehicles be operated in excess of fifteen (15) miles per hour. On passenger loading ramps and in areas adjacent to hangars, speed shall not exceed ten (10) miles per hour.
- 6. Vehicles shall be parked only in designated parking lots, on assigned tiedown spots, or inside hangers. In addition, vehicles shall be parked in a manner as to not obstruct aircraft movement or prevent ingress or egress to any taxiway, hangar entrances or tiedown spots.
- 7. Extended vehicle parking is allowed only as approved in advance by the airport manager. Overnight parking of vehicles by airport tenants is authorized only when tenant's aircraft is away from the airport. Overnight parking of motorhomes and commercial vehicles is not permitted.
- 8. Vehicles which are not in compliance with airport parking requirements are subject to towing at the owners expense.
- 9. No person shall perform any business or operate any vehicle for hire on or from the Airport without an appropriate permit from the County and in compliance with all conditions as may be prescribed by the County.
