



Our mission is to grow urban tree canopy in Midpeninsula communities for the benefit of all.




### Atherton Side of NFO is Cooler







• Events: 5



### MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT FOR TREE PLANTING/LANDSCAPING IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the APPLICANT is the Property Owner at

WHEREAS, the APPLICANT has desires to plant tree(s) and/or landscaping


improvement(s) (IMPROVEMENTS) within the public Right-of-Way as shown in Exhibit A; and

WHERAS, the County has jurisdiction of the Right-of-Way where IMPROVEMENTS will be placed; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree that APPLICANT's planting of IMPROVEMENTS within the public Right-of-Way would benefit the public.

### NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE COUNTY'S APPROVALS AND THE PUBLIC BENEFITS THAT WILL RESULT, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- APPLICANT, at its own cost and expense, shall maintain IMPROVEMENTS, attached as
   Exhibit A, in good condition and repair and in a manner that avoids the creation of any
   hazards to the public. Maintenance obligations include but not limited to: watering, weeding,
   trimming branches (7' height min.), removing dead limbs, sweeping and removing fallen
   leaves, trimming branches to prevent encircling powerline, etc.
- The APPLICANT shall defend, save harmless and indemnify the County, its officers, agents, employees, invitees, and contractors, and each of them, from and against any and all losses incurred in connection with IMPROVEMENTS(s).
- The term "APPLICANT," shall include not only the APPLICANT but also heirs, successors, executors, administrators and assigns.

# For trees planted in the public right-of-way:

- Expand the approved tree list
- Reduce the permit fees
- Reconsider maintenance responsibility to not fall purely on residents
