# **PROJECT UPDATES**

### July 2021 Activities

- On July 15<sup>th</sup>, the County hosted a preview of the MJLHMP Volume 1 Draft for Steering Committee Members and Planning Partners. This information was also be presented at the sixth and final Steering Committee meeting on July 26<sup>th</sup>.
- The County team also continued to do community presentations on the MJLHMP in July, including a presentation to the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Committee.
- Survey #2 closed on July 11<sup>th</sup>. We received over 700 responses (82% in English and 18% in Spanish).
   Responses informed the development of mitigation actions.
- Phase 3 assignments were due on July 23<sup>rd</sup> from the County and all Planning Partners. All 36 Partners sent their information on or before the deadline. In Phase 3, mitigation actions were developed and prioritized.

# **August 2021 Activities**

- On August 5<sup>th</sup>, the Draft MJLHMP will be released for public comment. Media Release #3 and social media will be used to announce the availability of the Draft.
- A Public Workshop will be held on Thursday, August 12<sup>th</sup> from 4 pm to 5:30 pm. The Draft Plan will be explained and an opportunity for public comment will be provided.
- Public comment on the Draft closes on August 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- The Draft MJLHMP will be submitted to Cal OES and FEMA for concurrent review no later than August 31<sup>st</sup>.
