

PROJECT UPDATES

June 2021 Activities

- 36 Annex Partners are participating in the MJLHMP. Partners include all the cities in the County, as well as 15 special districts.
- On June 4th, Media Release #2 was released and kicked off Survey #2 which seeks input on mitigation actions from community members.
- Four workshops for Planning Partners were held on June 14th, 15th and 16th and weekly Question & Answer sessions began on June 23rd and will run through July 21st to assist Planning Partners.
- On June 10th, the County hosted a preview of the MJLHMP Hazards Risk Assessment data for Steering Committee Members and Planning Partners and also provided that information at the fifth Steering Committee meeting which was held on June 28th.

July 2021 Activities

On July 15th, the County will host a preview of the MJLHMP Volume 1 Draft for Steering Committee Members and Planning Partners. This information will also be presented at the sixth and final Steering Committee meeting on July 26th.

Public Workshor

- The County team will also continue to do community presentations on the MJLHMP in July, including presentations to the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Committee and the Menlo Park City Council.
- Phase 3 assignments are due on July 23rd from the County and all Planning Partners. In Phase 3, mitigation actions are developed and prioritized.
- The consultants will then complete the draft MJLHMP, which will be released for public comment on August 5th. Public comment will run through August 23rd with a Public Workshop occurring on August 12th.
