

San Mateo County Veterans Fund

The San Mateo County Veterans Fund was created in 2017 and is administered by the San Mateo County Human Services Agency's County Veterans Office to support veterans' initiatives and the needs of the County veteran population. The 2011-2015 American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates report that there are 28,739 veterans residing in San Mateo County.

Contributions to the Veterans Fund will be considered as a general donation deposited to the Veterans Trust Fund to be used for extraordinary one-time requests to support veteran individuals who are currently being served by County programs.

Extraordinary requests are to fill a special need that is not able to be met through any other funding source or program. Examples of one-time extraordinary needs can include:

- Education related expenses (books, course)
- Required equipment not covered by other funding sources
- Scholarships
- Employment related support
- Re-integration activities
- Other related needs

This fund will not pay for administrative or operational expenses; 100% of donated funds are deposited directly to the Veterans Trust Fund account. Funding requests for the Veterans Fund program will be accepted and reviewed by the County Veterans Services Office.
