

-83 people were interviewed from 17 different cities.


How concerned are you about present-day flooding? (83 responses)

- 30.1 percent is more concerned than not.


How concerned are you about future sea level rise? (83 responses)

When it comes to "solving" climate change, which of the below is the MOST IMPORTANT group to involve in the solution?




