Subject: LAFCo File No. 14-02—Application by the City of Redwood City to Extend Sewer

Service to 1278 Edgewood Road, Unincorporated San Mateo County

#### **Summary**

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56133, Commission approval is required for extension of service by local agencies to territory outside the agency's boundaries. This section requires that the public agency apply to LAFCo by resolution on behalf of the property owners. In this case, the City of Redwood City has applied for extension of sewer service to an existing single-family home with a failing septic system at 1278 Edgewood Road. Commission approval is recommended.

#### Staff Report and Recommendation

This proposal was submitted by resolution of the City of Redwood City in response to application by the property owners in order to abandon a failing septic system and connect to the City sewer line running in Edgewood Road. The subject area is within the sphere of influence of the City of Redwood City and not within the boundaries of a County sewer or sanitation district.

Section 56133 allows LAFCo to approve extension of sewer service in anticipation of annexation. The subject parcel is not contiguous to the City boundary and therefore not eligible for annexation at this time. Edgewood Road fronting the parcel is within County jurisdiction. For this reason, a road encroachment permit from the San Mateo County Department of Public Works will be required for sewer and lateral construction work in the roadway.

San Mateo County Environmental Health Division reports that the City of Redwood City provides the available water and the parcel is not within the boundaries of a County sewer or sanitation district. The proposal has no adverse environmental health significance.

The City of Redwood City's resolution requesting LAFCo approval of sewer extension includes the following City conditions of approval:

- Payment of LAFCo fees by the applicant
- Approval of construction drawings by the San Mateo County Building Department
- Payment of all applicable Redwood City fees

- Property owner to install, or pay the City to install, a new sewer service line
- Property owner to be responsible for the design, construction, and connection of any sewer main modifications or extensions needed to provide adequate capacity for domestic use
- Property owner to pay the fees for any construction permits associated with the abovementioned improvements and any associated costs for plan review and inspections
- Property owner to adhere to all review comments and conditions of service stipulated by the City.

#### California Environmental Quality Act

The City of Redwood City, acting as lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), found that the project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15303(d) of the CA Public Resources Code, Class 3, regarding water main, sewage, and other utilities to serve exempt facilities.

### **Executive Officer's Recommendation:**

- 1. By motion, certify that the sewer extension is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15303(d) of the CA Public Resources Code, Class 3.
- 2. By motion, approve LAFCo File No. 14-02—Proposed Extension of Sewer Service by the City of Redwood City to 1278 Edgewood Road and direct the Executive Officer to send a letter of approval to the City and the property owners.





WHEREAS, the property located at 1278 Edgewood Rd, in unincorporated San Mateo County, California (APN 058-030-090) (the "Property"), is outside the City's jurisdictional boundaries, but inside City's sphere of influence and sewer service area; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo is processing an application for a building permit to construct a new sewer lateral at the property that requires sewer service from the City of Redwood city; and

WHEREAS, the Property owner has requested that the City of Redwood City provide sewer service to the property at 1278 Edgewood Rd; and

WHEREAS, the sewer service connection proposed for the single family residence at the property is subject to the following conditions and fees:

- 1. LAFCo approval of the application for the proposed sewer service connection;
  - Property owner's payment of LAFCo fees;
- 3. After approval of the construction drawings by the San Mateo County Building Department and upon application for new sewer service, property owner's

payment of all applicable Redwood City fees, including connection fees associated with

providing proposed sewer service;

4. Property owner's installation, or payment for the City to install, a new

sewer service line;

5. Property owner is responsible for the design, construction, and connection

of any sewer main modifications, expansions, or extensions necessary to provide

adequate flow for domestic use and fire suppression, in accordance to City Code

Section 38.26 and as determined by City;

6. Property owner shall pay the fees for any construction permit in

connection with all above improvements, and shall pay associated costs for plan review

and inspections; and

7. The owner of the property shall adhere to all the review comments and

conditions of service stated by the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

**REDWOOD CITY. AS FOLLOWS:** 

1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to submit

an application to the Local Agency Formation Commission requesting approval of an

extension of the sewer service outside the City's jurisdictional boundaries and within the

City's sphere of influence and sewer service area to the property at 1278 Edgewood Rd,

unincorporated San Mateo County, California (APN 058-030-090) pursuant to California

Government Code Section 56133 of the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government

Reorganization Act of 2000.
