

Slip Transfers

We get a lot of questions about transferring slips at Coyote Point when a boat is sold. Please see the guidelines below. Slips are transferrable under the following conditions:

- The new owner must apply for the slip, be approved by the Marina office, and provide the required documentation (application, policies and procedures, license agreement, proof of land residence and proof of insurance) BEFORE the slip may transfer.
- The new owner must provide proof of registration in their name within 30 days.
- The boat must meet the same requirements that a boat from outside of the Marina would have to meet: Good cosmetic and operating condition, current safety equipment, and a recent survey if the boat is over 30 years old or is built of anything other than fiberglass. The Harbormaster may reject the transfer application based on the condition of the boat.

Please be sure the purchaser is aware of all Marina rules, especially the 3-night per week lodging limit and the prohibition on renting out the boat as a hotel room or other commercial activity.

Once you have agreement with the purchaser, choose a date to transfer the slip. That's the date you will stop paying the slip fees and the new owner will start. As long as the new owner is approved, completes all requirements and makes the first month's payment by that date you do not need to give 30-days' notice.

If the purchaser is removing the boat from Coyote Point you are required to give 30-days written notice. There is a form at the office for this.

This can be a bit confusing, so if you have any questions don't hesitate to call the office. We are here to help!



Battery Blues

Unfortunately, there has been a big increase in the number of batteries that have been left at the disposal site next to the oil shed. Most batteries left there recently are not lead-acid batteries and are not from boats at the marina. The marina must pay to dispose of these batteries and the cost has become significant.

So – we have temporarily stopped accepting any batteries for disposal. We hope to be able to reopen the battery disposal site soon, but we will only accept lead-acid batteries and household dry-cells (for example, flashlight batteries) from boats at the Marina. Nothing from outside the Marina will be accepted, and no commercial or gel cell batteries will be accepted. Thanks for your understanding.

Another reminder - please do not dispose of household waste in Marina dumpsters – these containers are for refuse generated aboard your boat! Thanks for your help.
