Hi, Camille.

For the CDRC meeting, file names shouldn't have punctuation or special characters in them. Letters, numbers, dashes and underscores only. The # symbol in the file name is most likely what's screwing up the link. The files will have to be renamed and reuploaded and the others removed. (Sorry, I'd do it but I'm busy this evening and leaving town early tomorrow for a funeral service.)

For the Highland Estates, yes and no. Breaking up the files themselves won't help, since the problem is that there are already too many files on that page. (I spoke to ISD and they agreed that the size of the file list has broken the page.) The break up I'm recommending would require creating new document content items with a portion of the files attached to each one. Then you list all those document items on a single page. Perhaps we break them up by date? Up to you.

That's probably going to be a big job, downloading and reuploading 250 files, some of which are nearly 250 MB. I can set up the list and show you guys how to add to it—and I can help move files around if you need that—but, again, not before next week. (Sorry.) A stop-gap which we could try on Monday would be to create

a document item for the new records and have the project page link to both the new records and the existing list.
